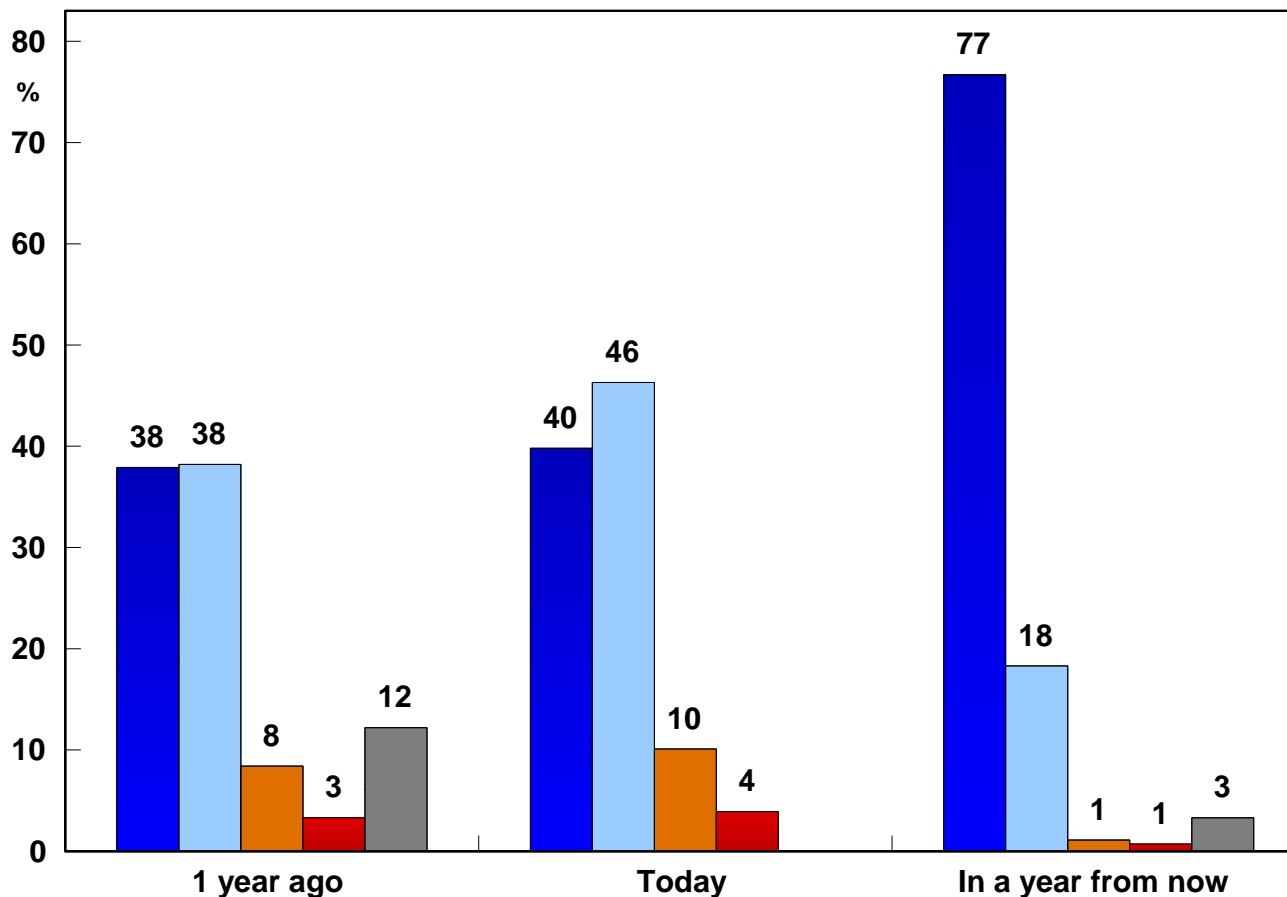
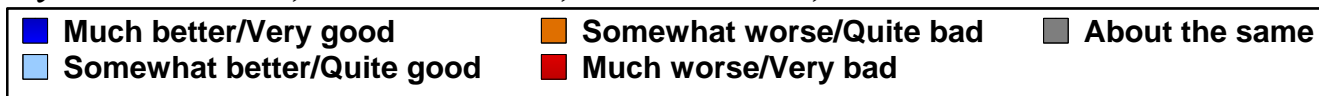


# Life Satisfaction in Past, Present, and Future

Q2B - What is your expectation for how things in your life will be overall in a year from now? Will they be much better, somewhat better, about the same, somewhat worse or much worse?

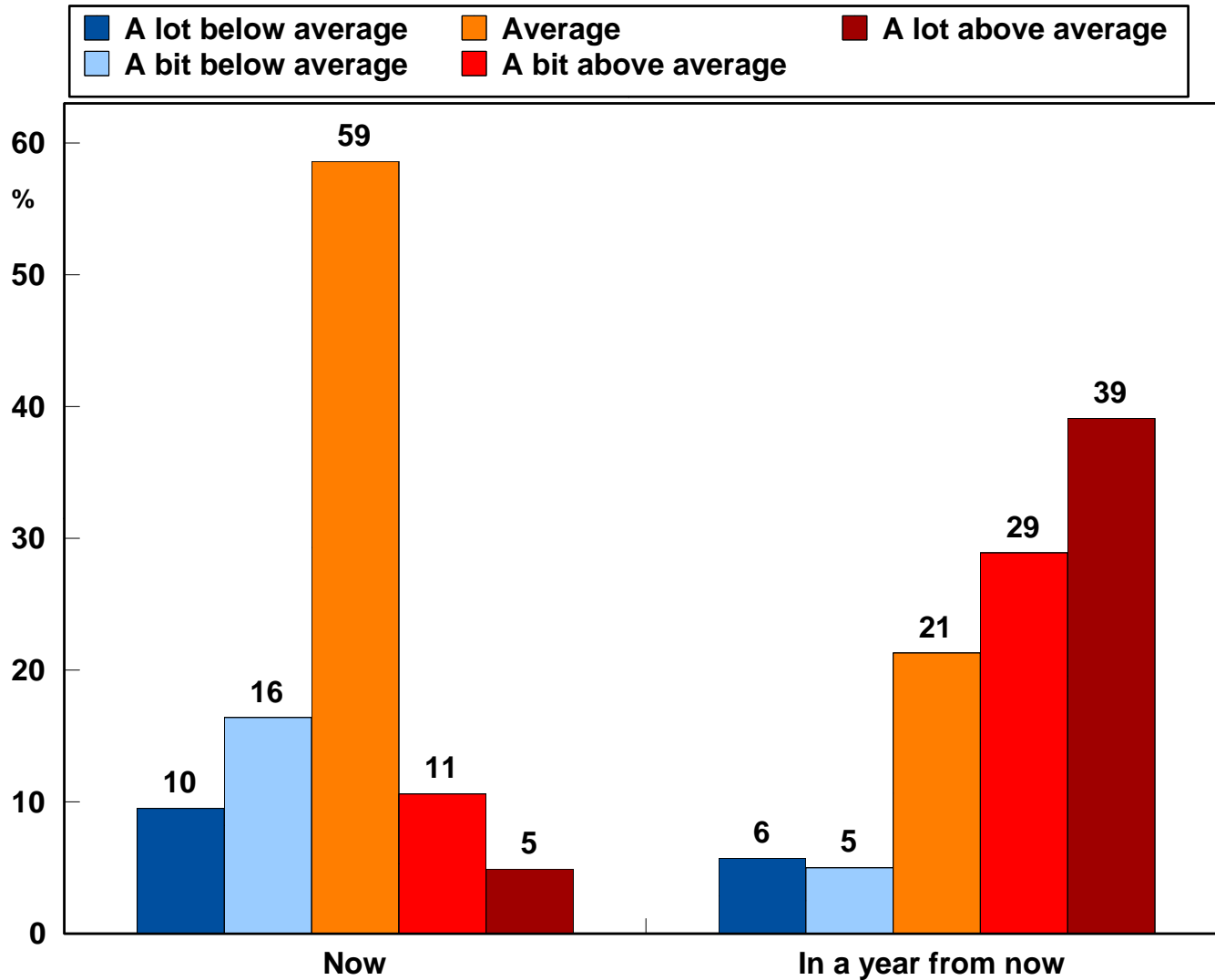

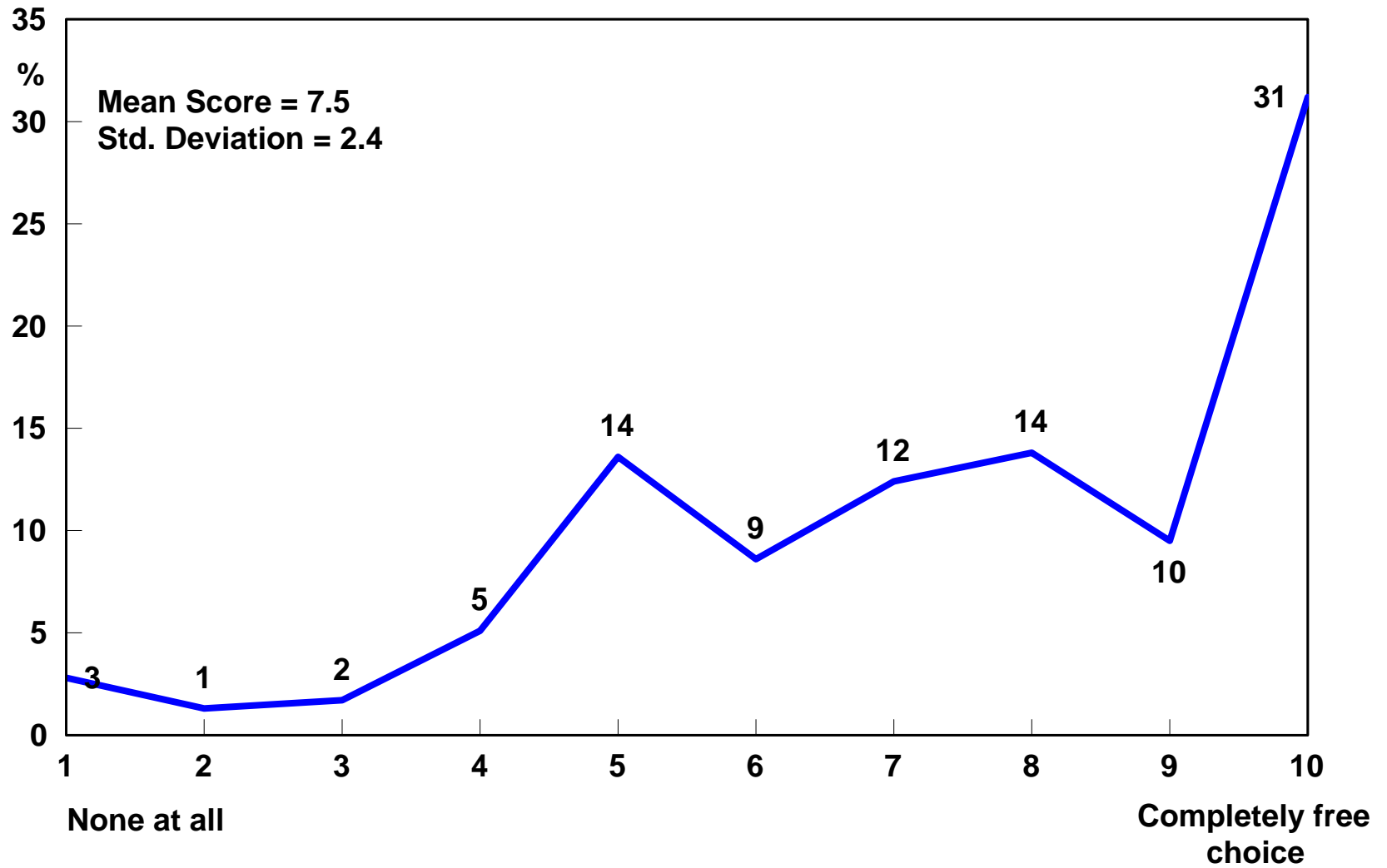
Q3A - How would you judge your household's standard of living compared with other households in your community?

Q3B - What do you expect your household's standard of living to be in 12 months time?



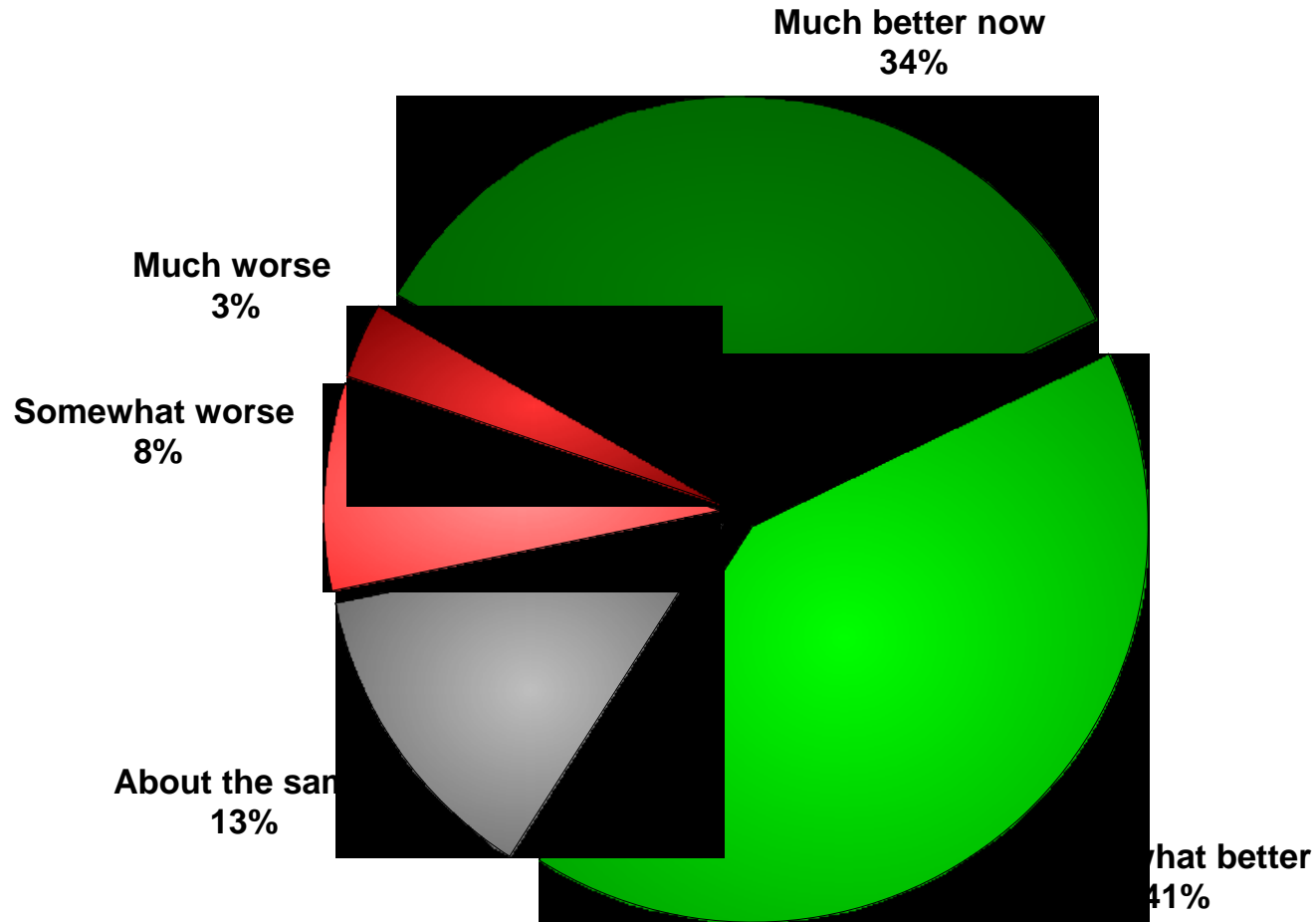
# Free Choice and Control over One's Life

Q4 - *Some people feel they have completely free choice and control over their lives, while other people feel that they have no real effect on what happens to them.*



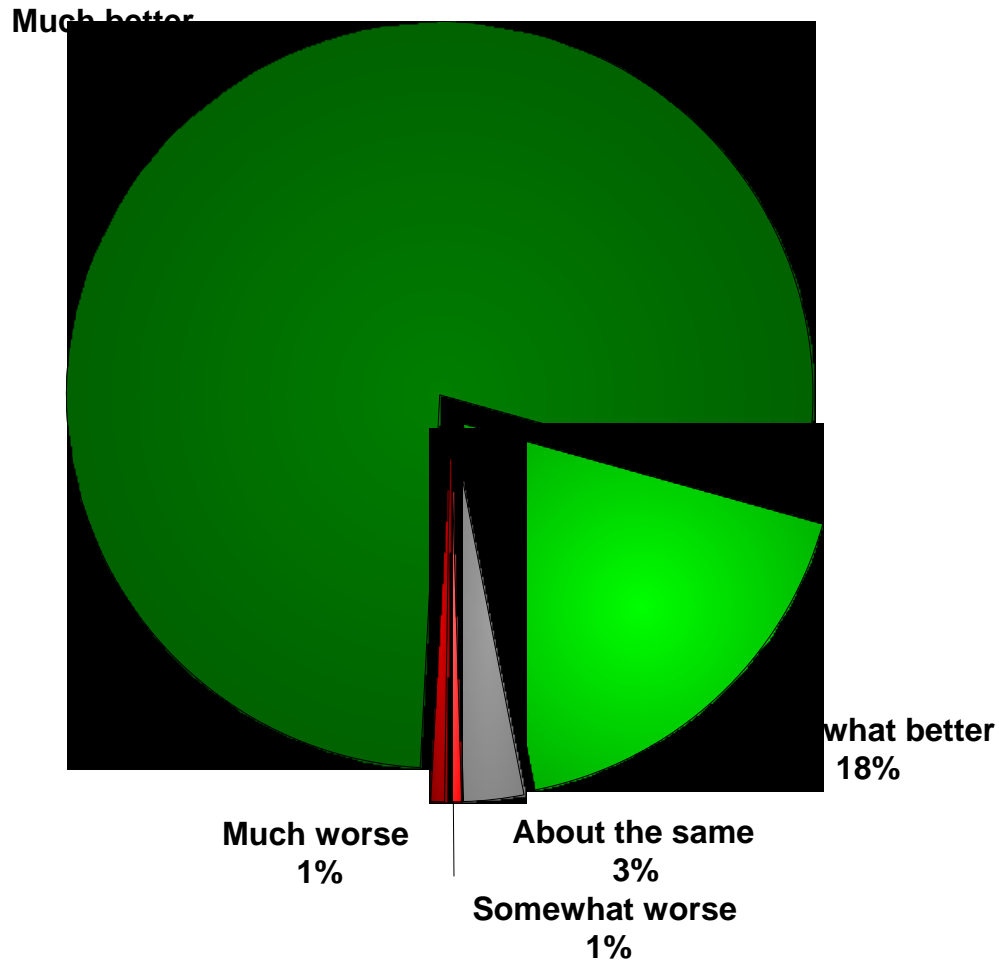
# Situation in Libya - Compared to Before the Revolution

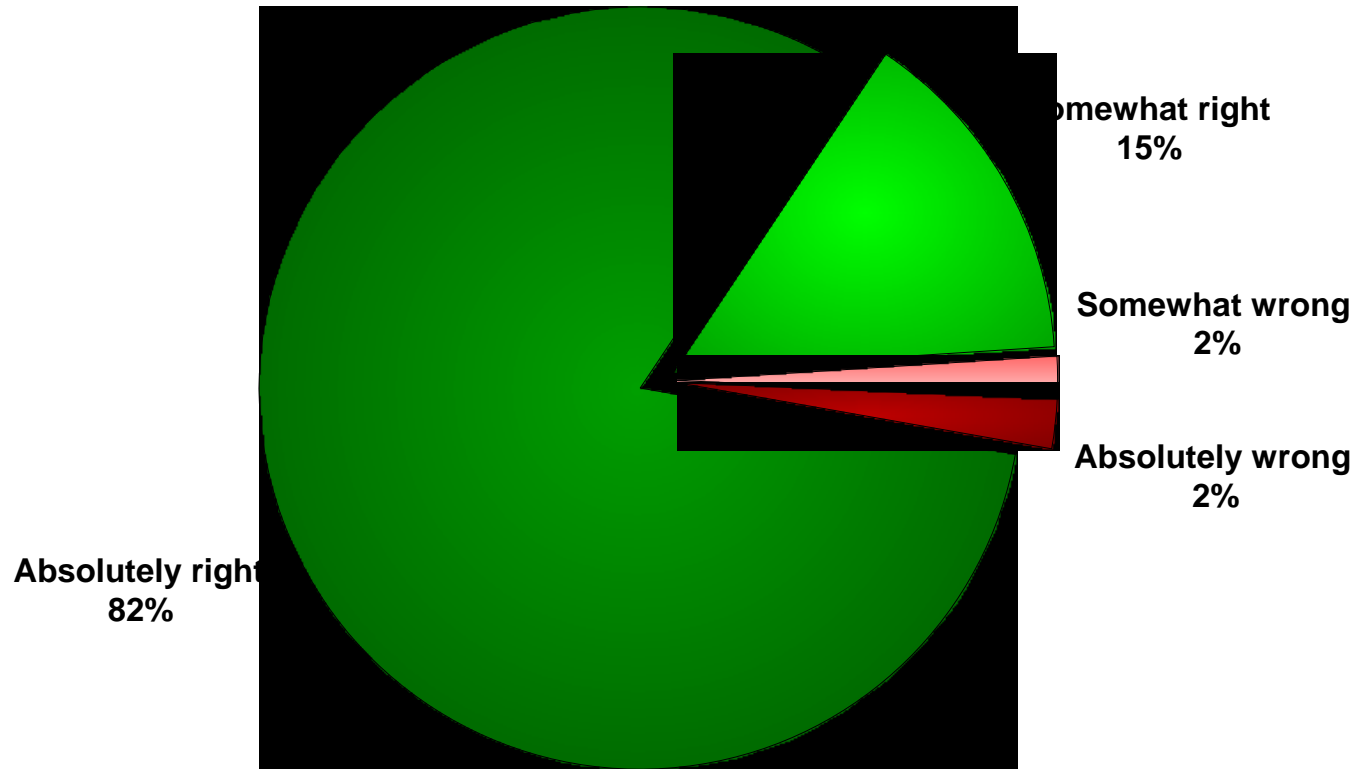

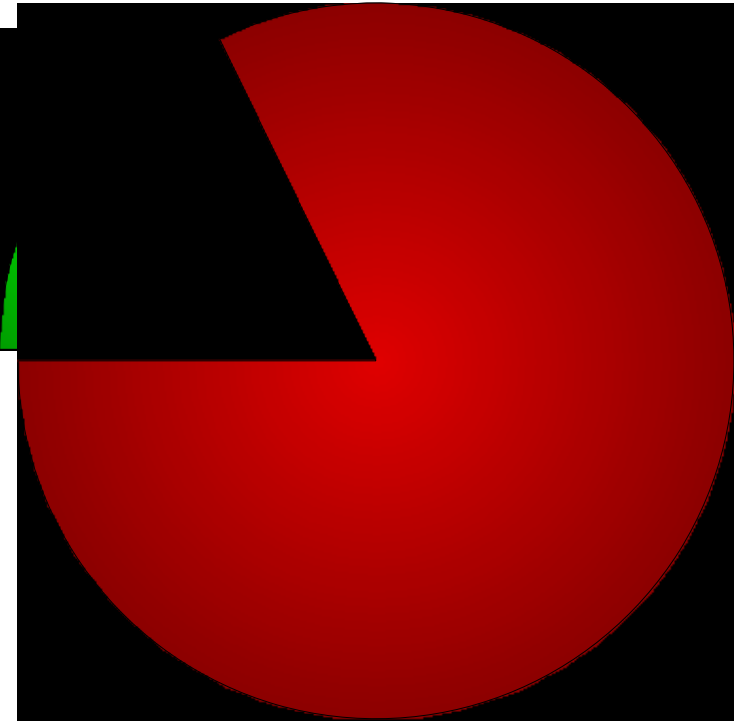

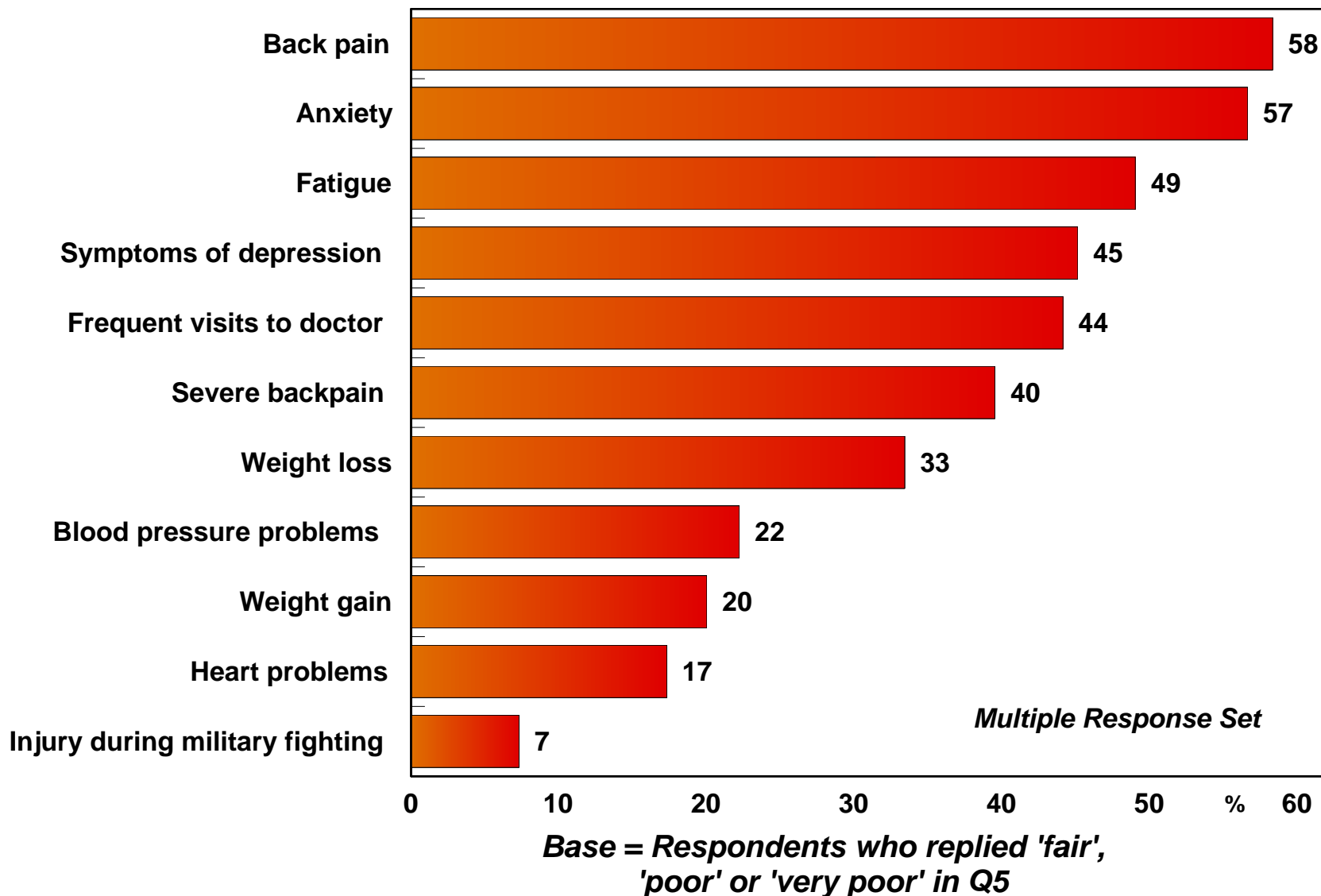

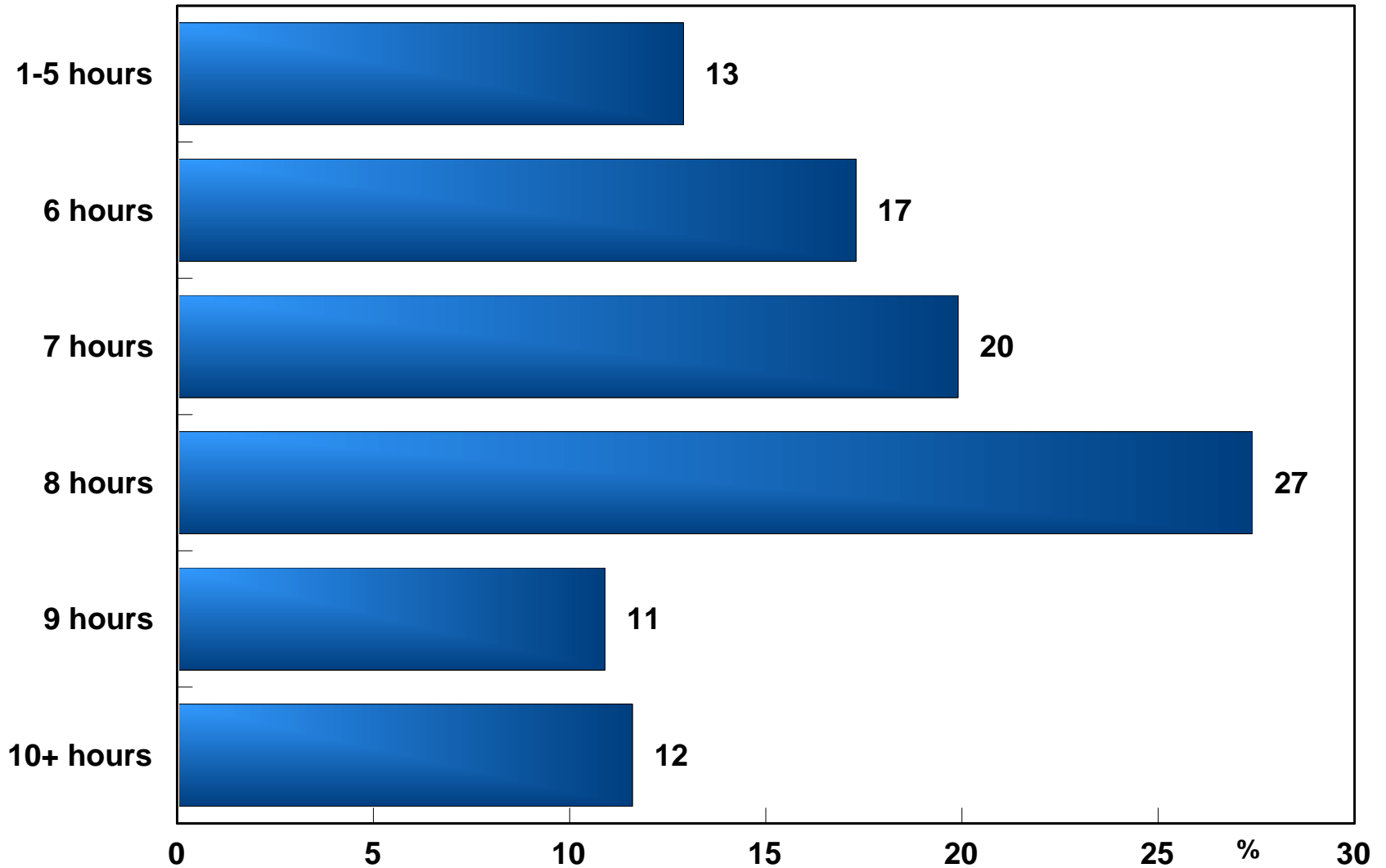

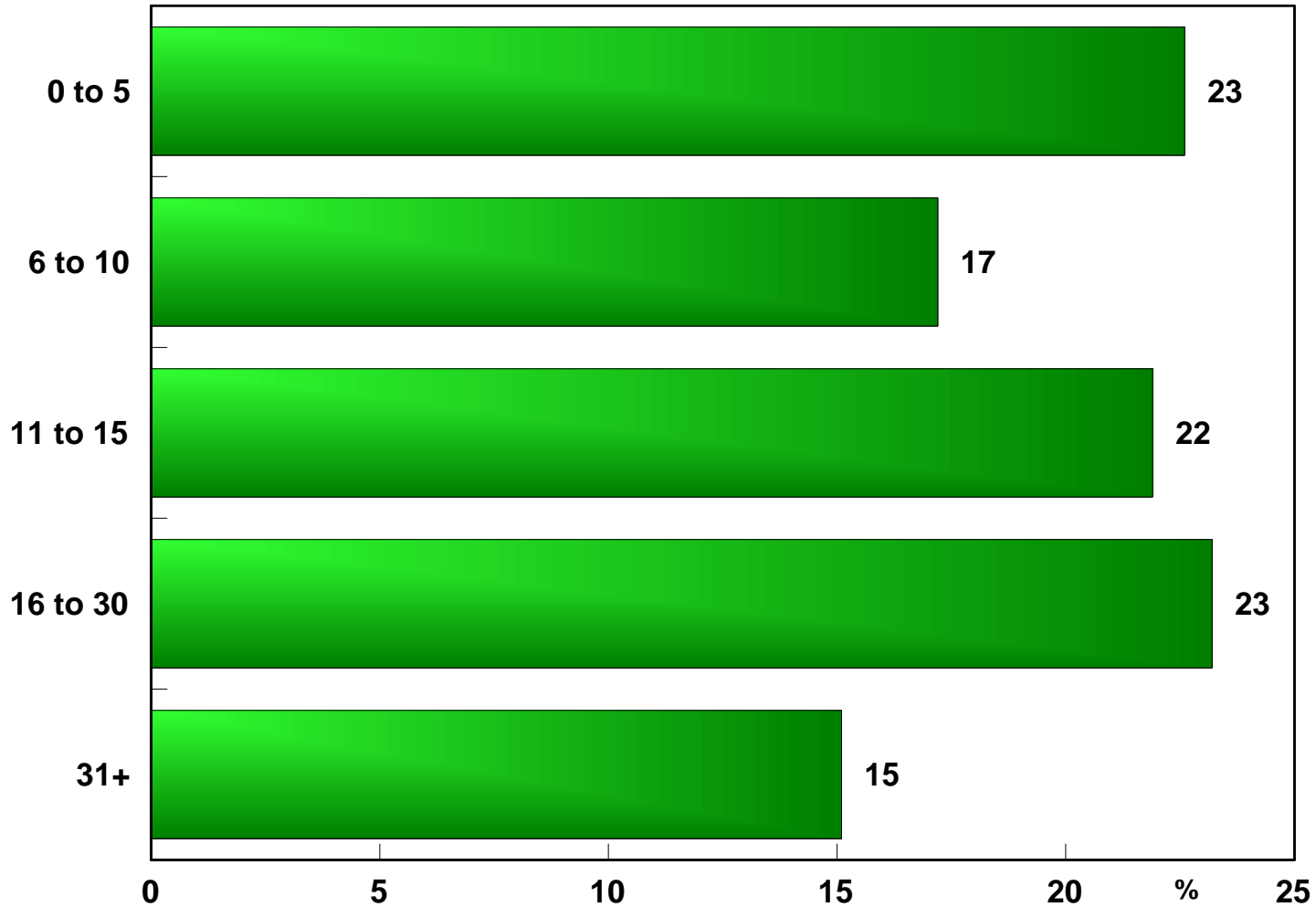
Q7 – On average, how many hours do you usually sleep at night?

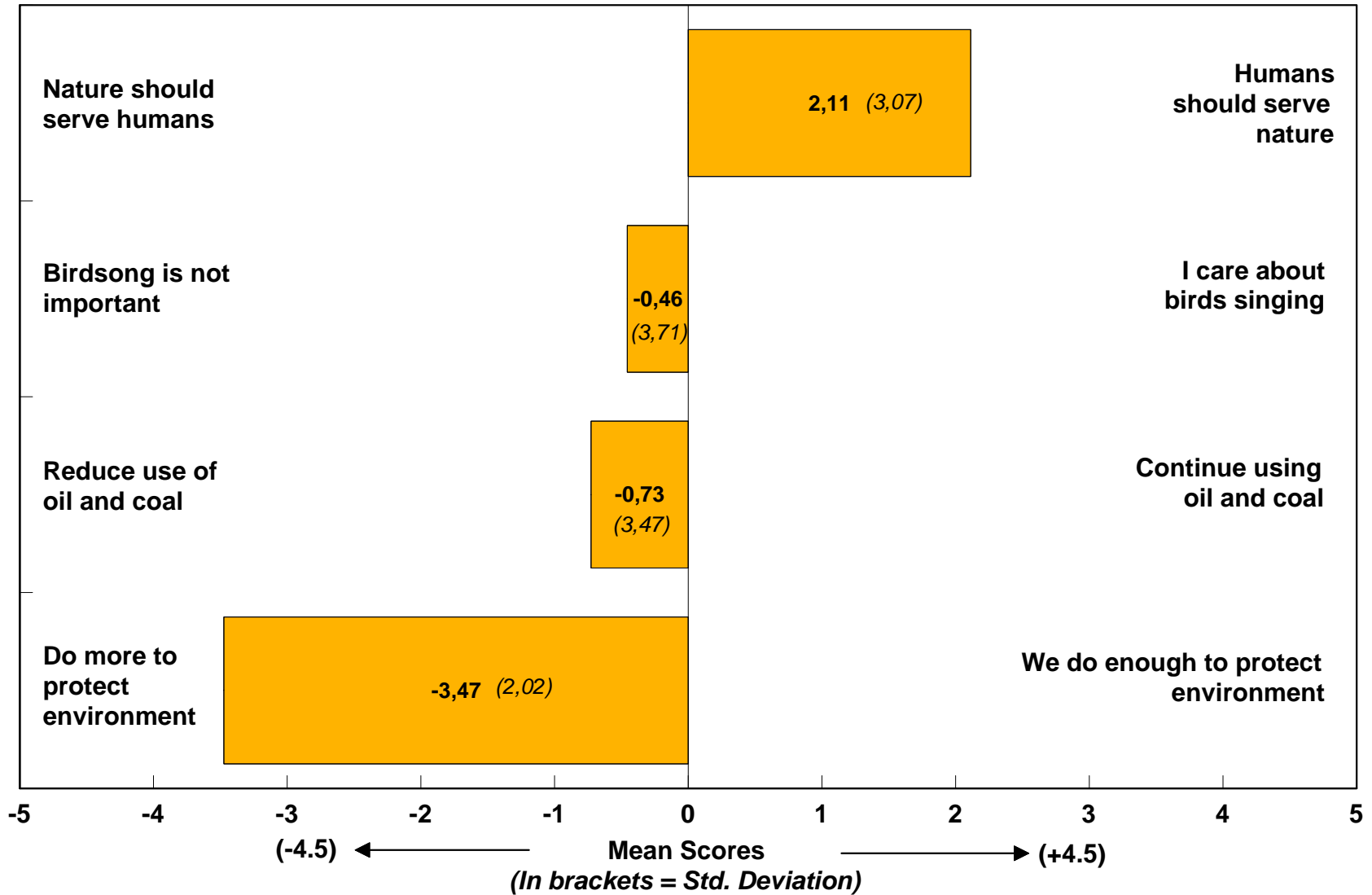

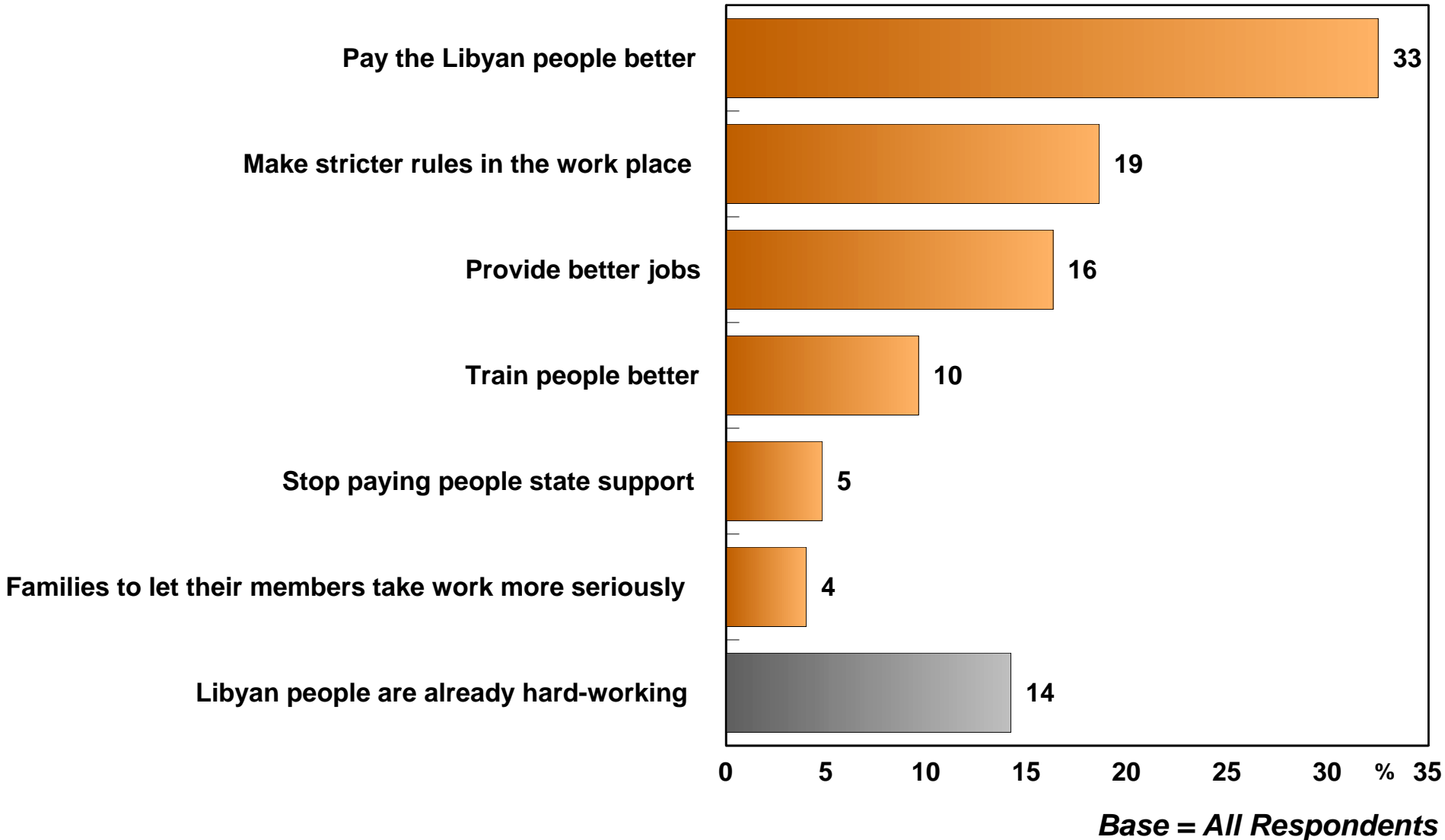

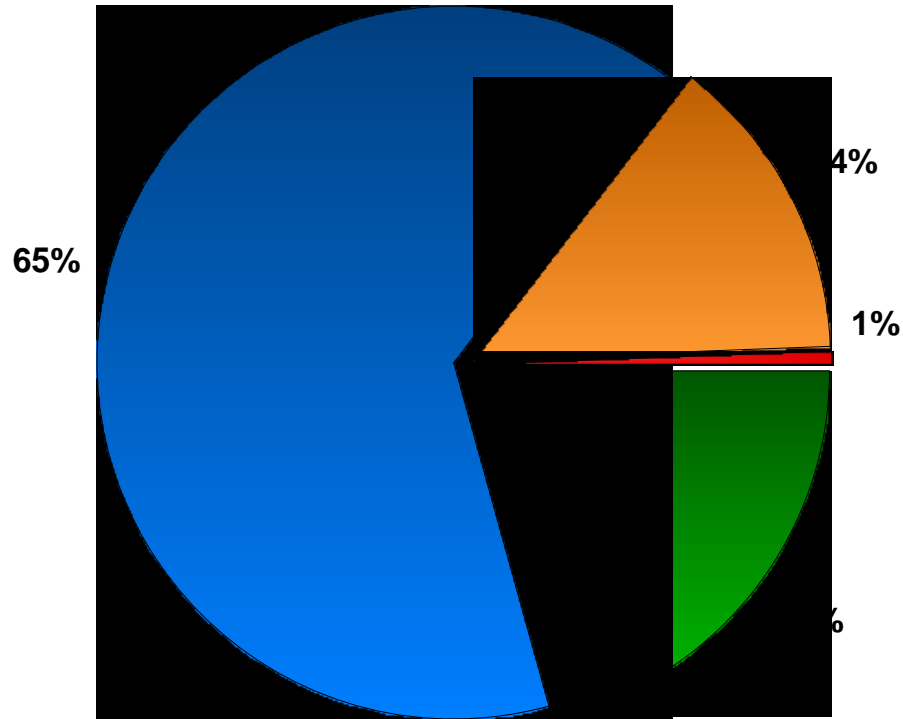

# Future Structure of Libya

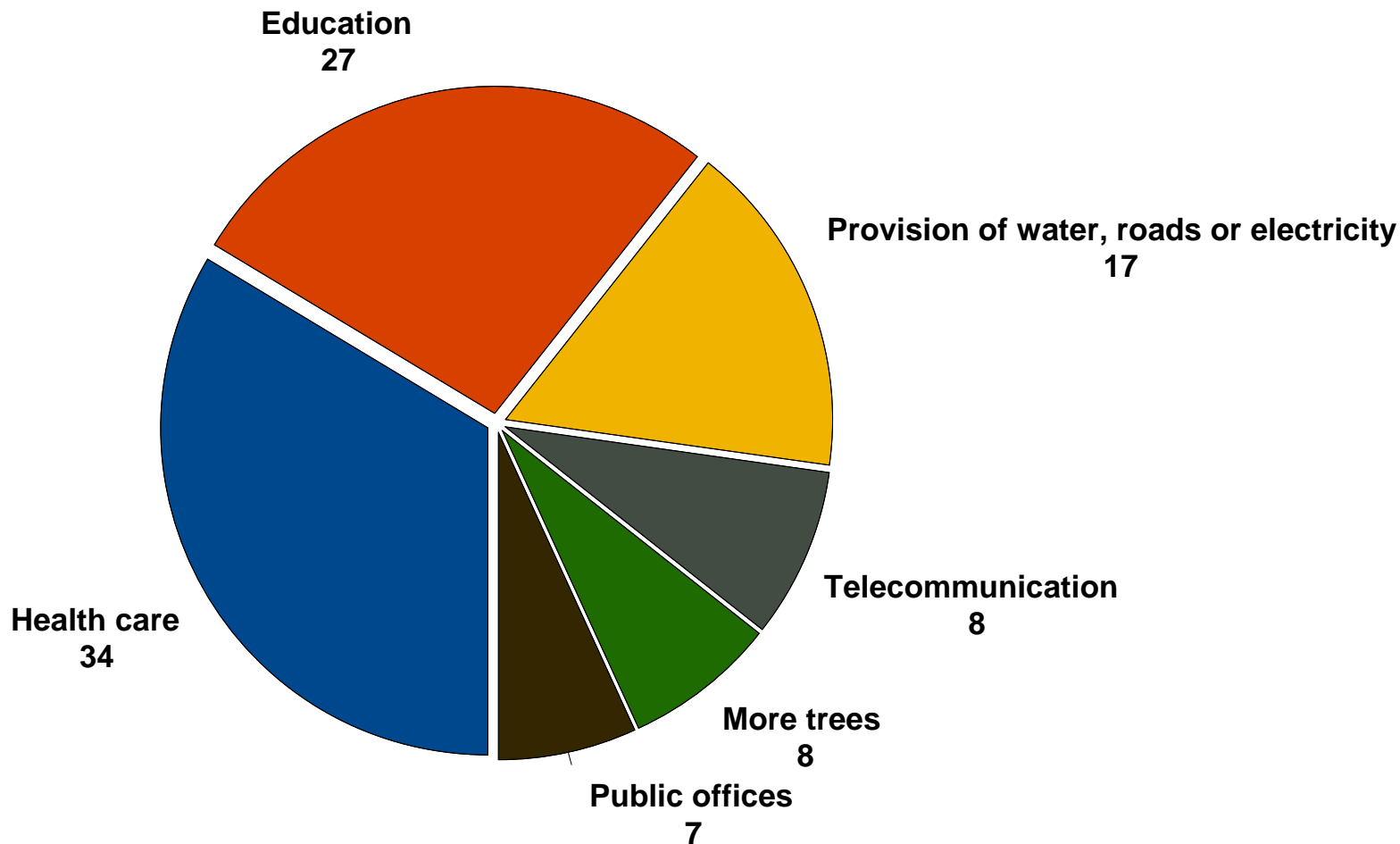
Q22 - Which structure should Libya have in future?

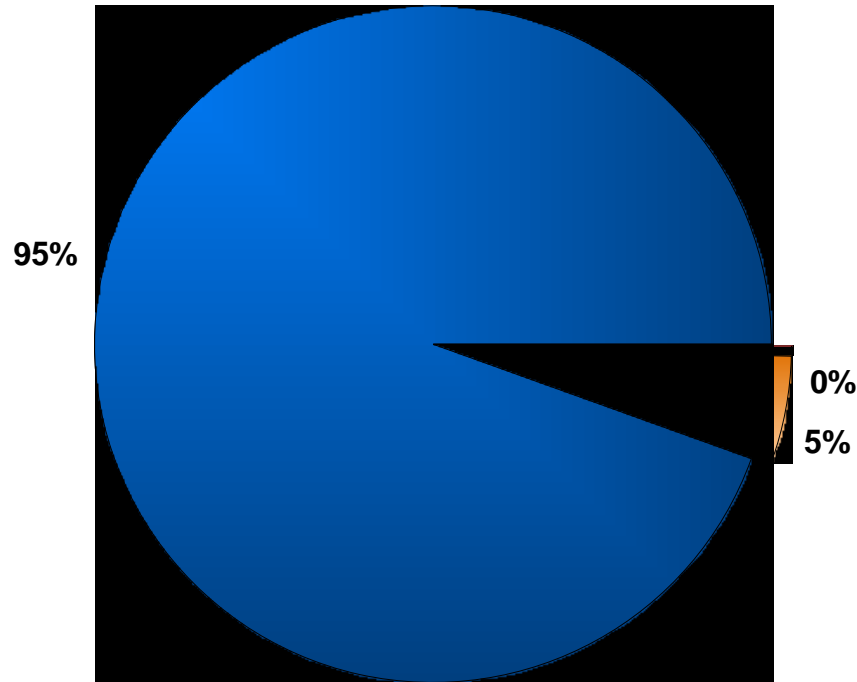

**Q23 - As you may know, Libya produces oil which it can sell abroad. Some regions have oil but others do not. How do you think the oil money should be distributed within Libya?**

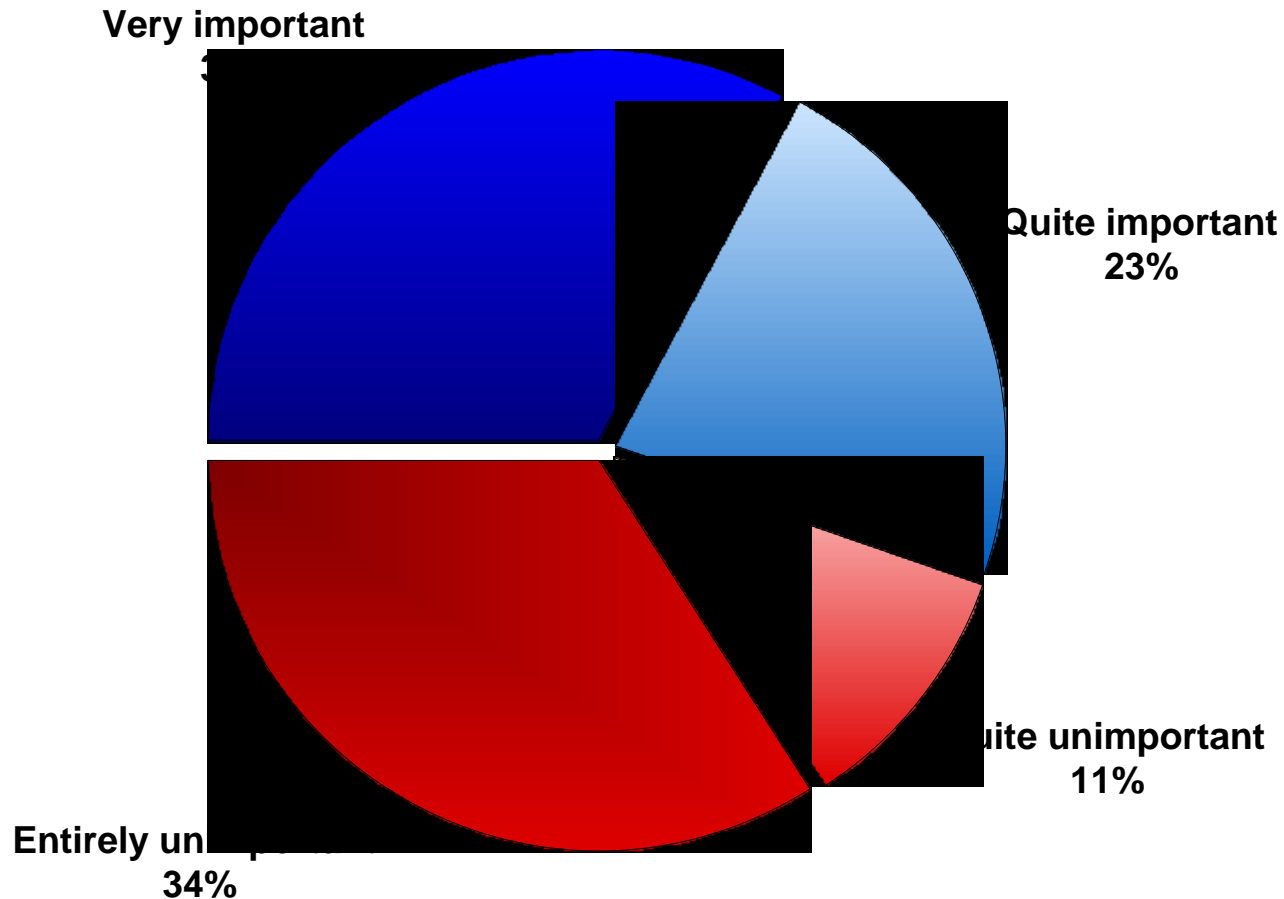


- The regions that have oil should keep all the money from oil sales for themselves

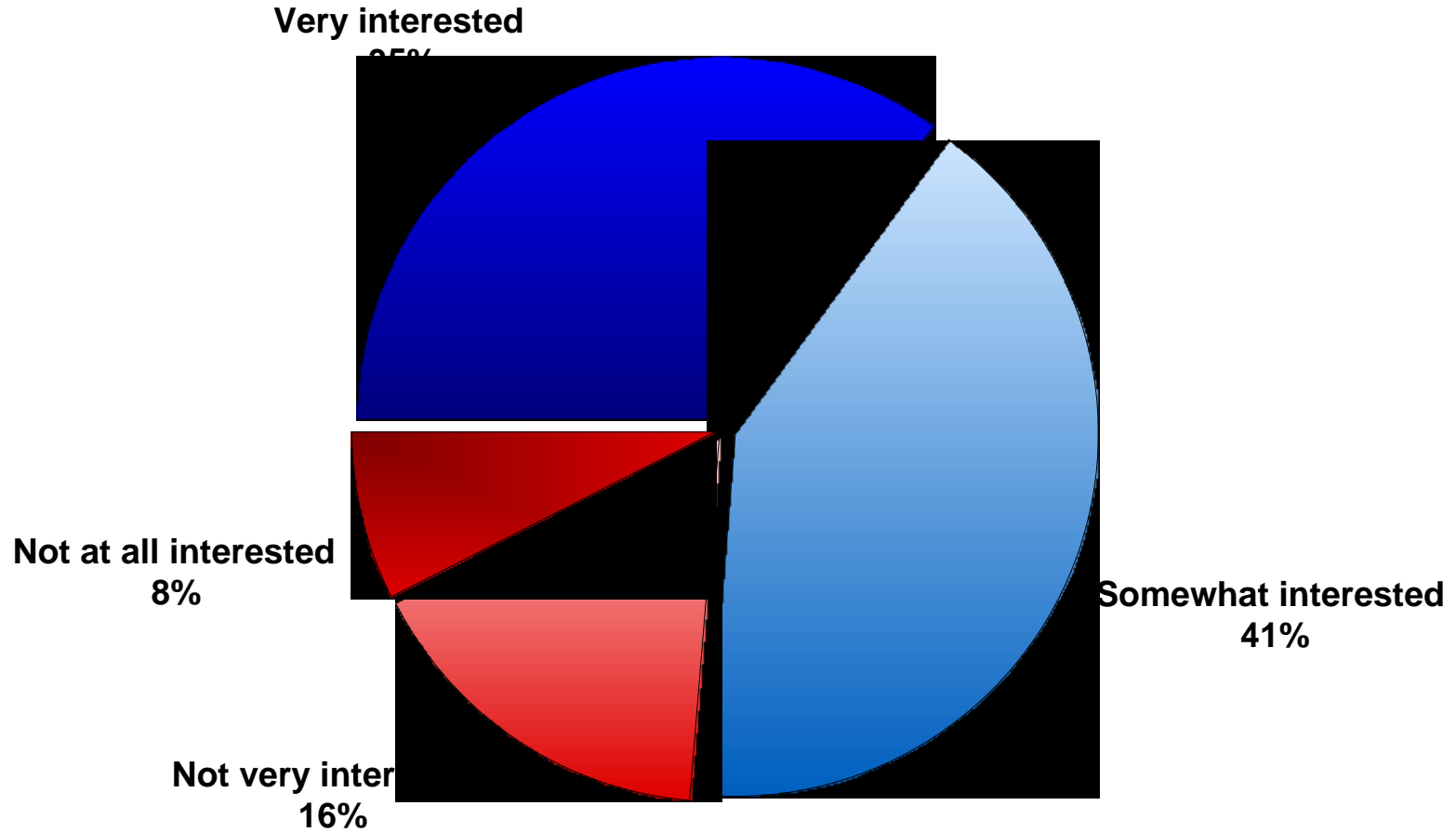

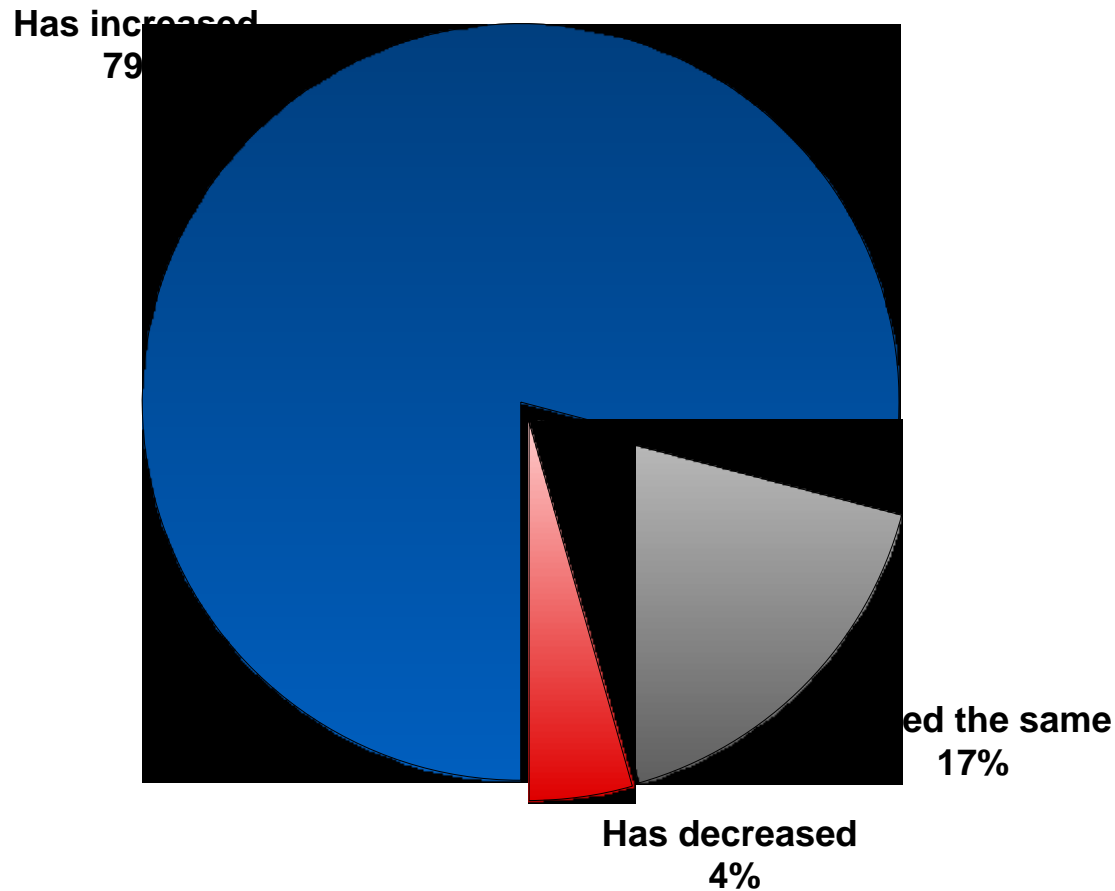

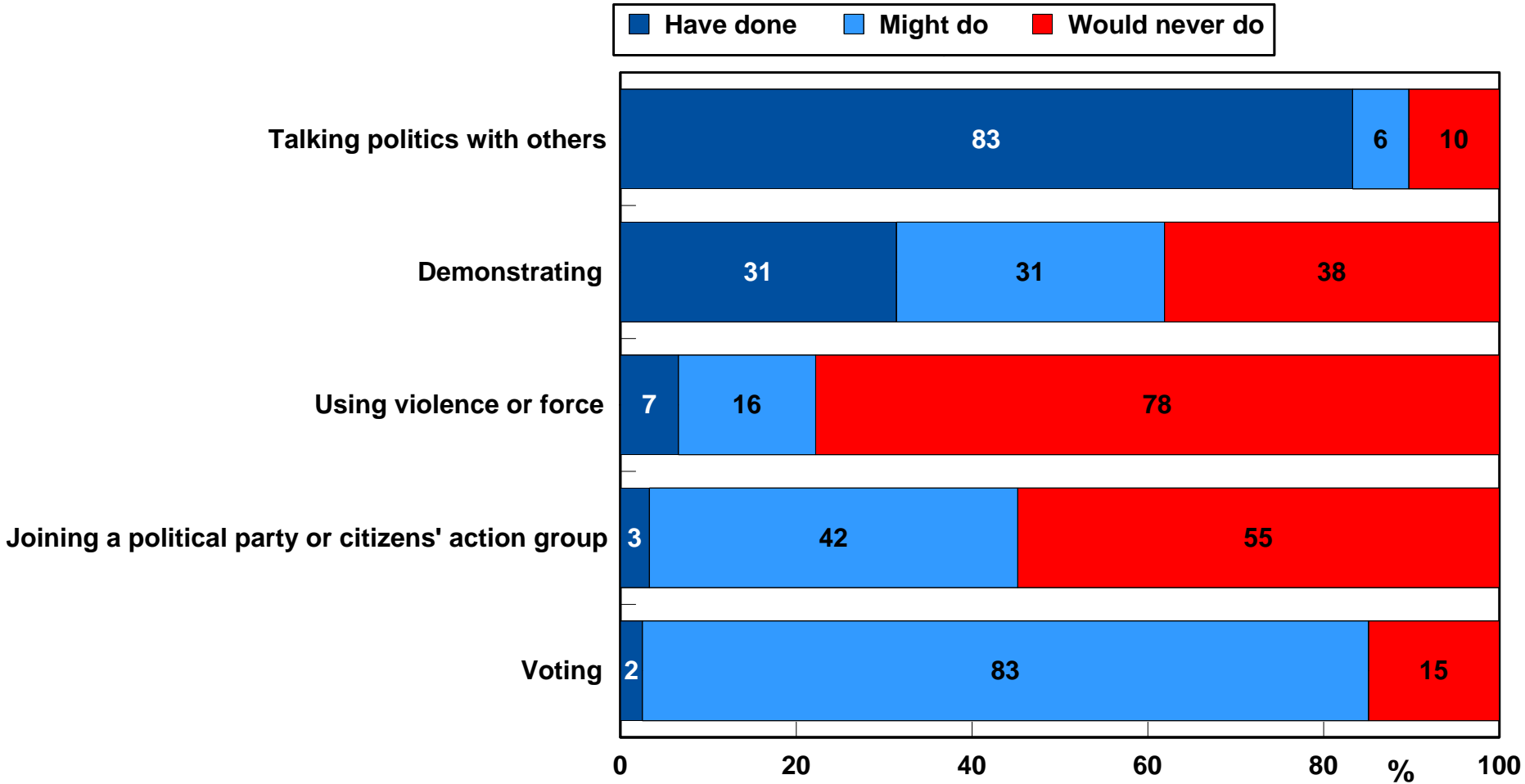

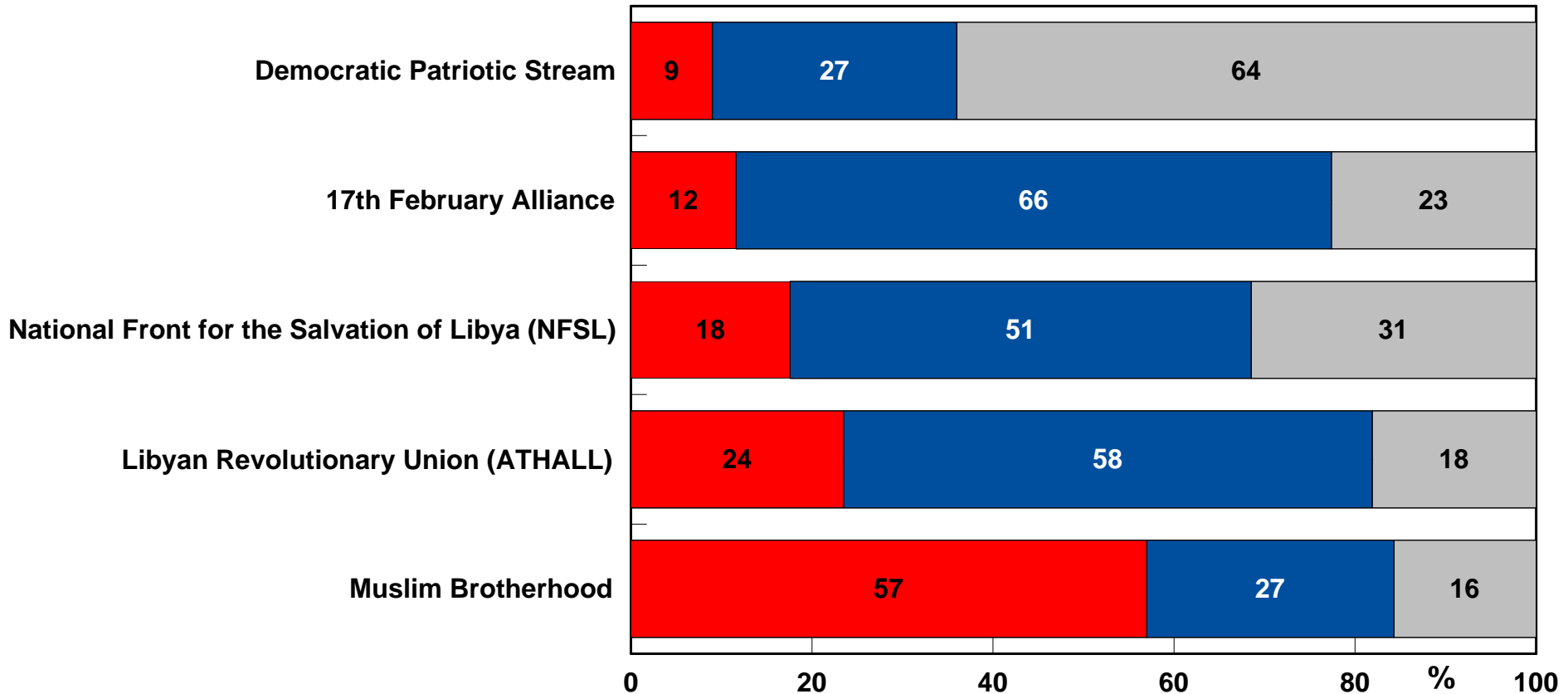

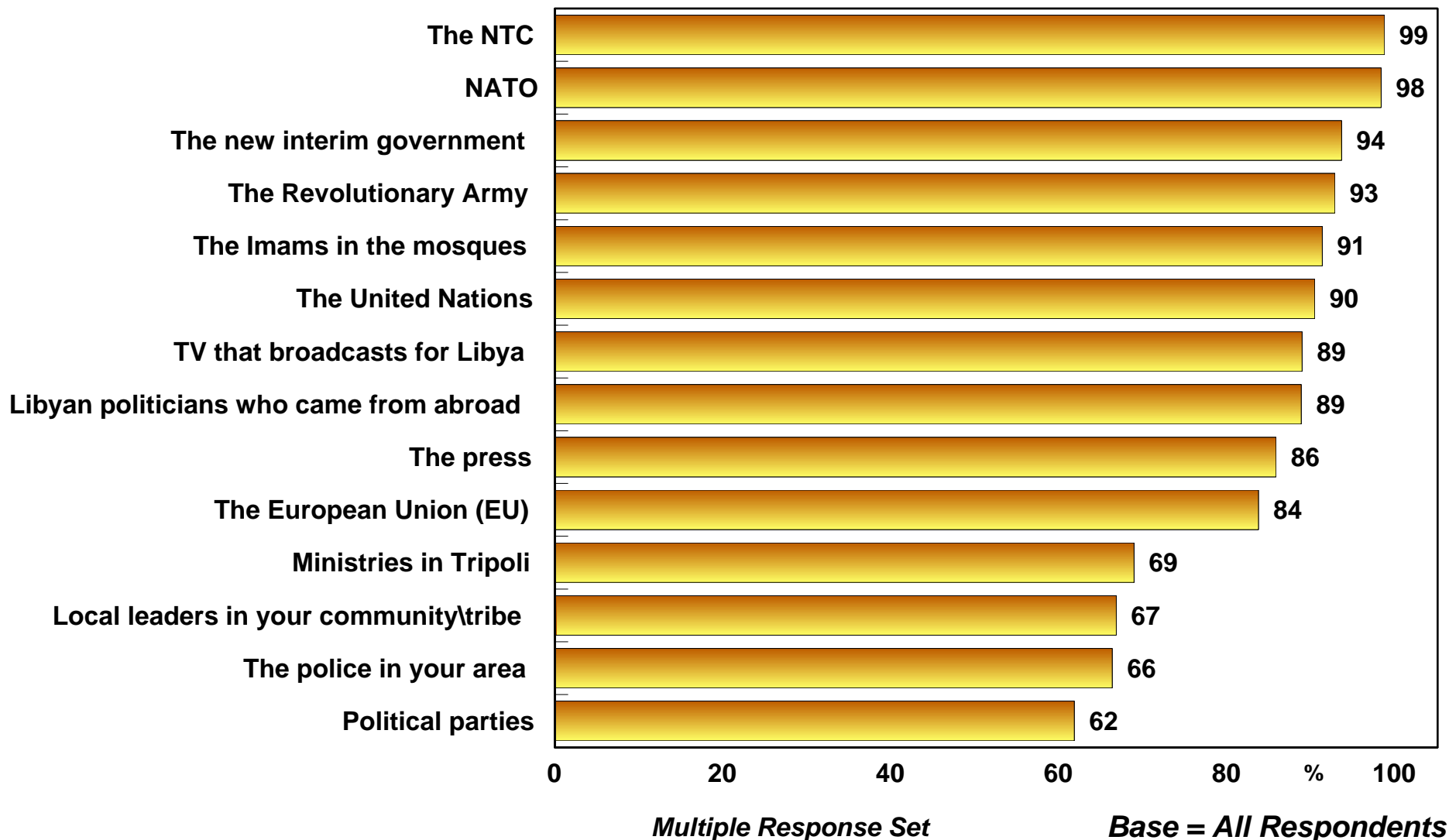

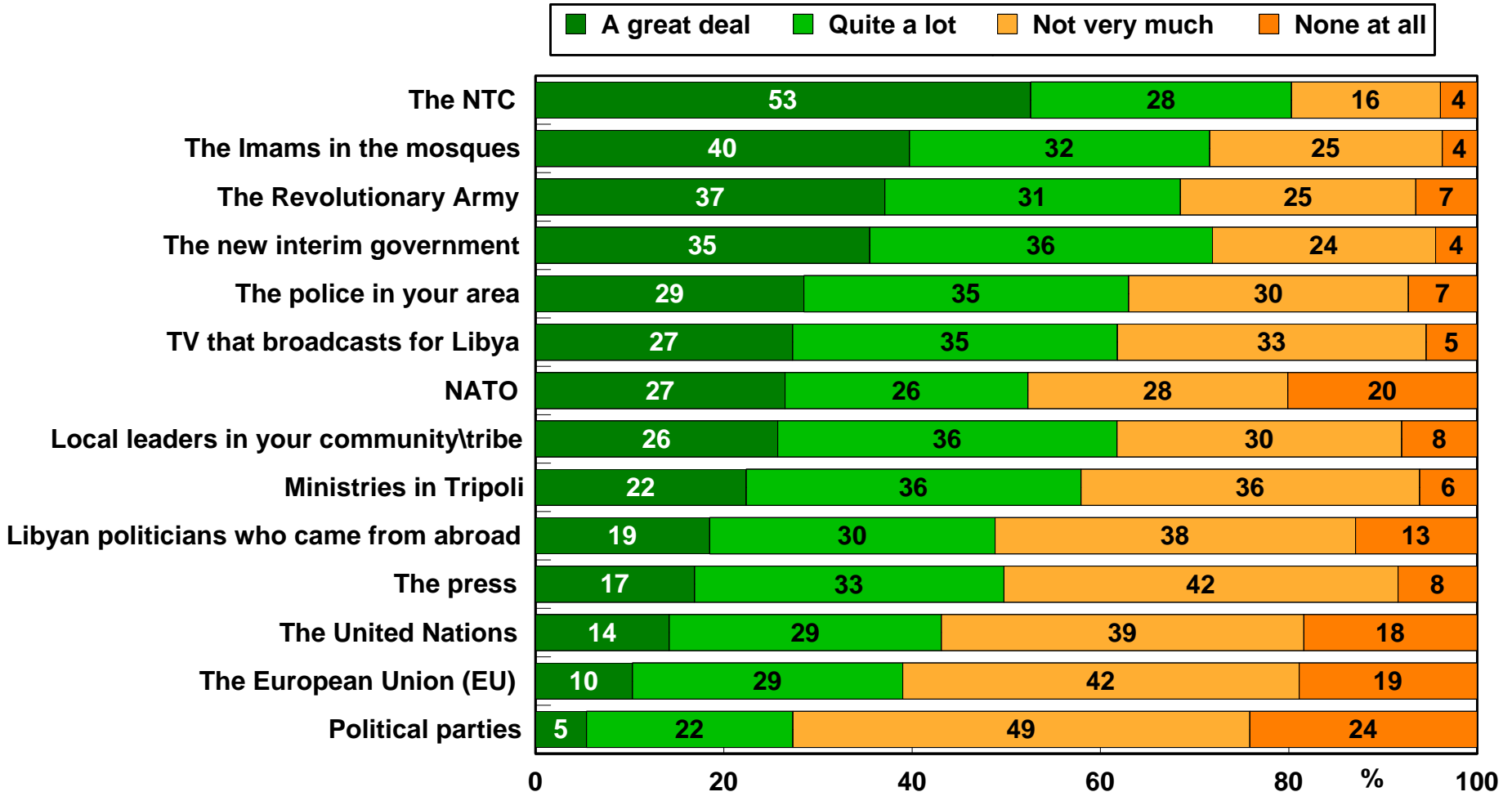

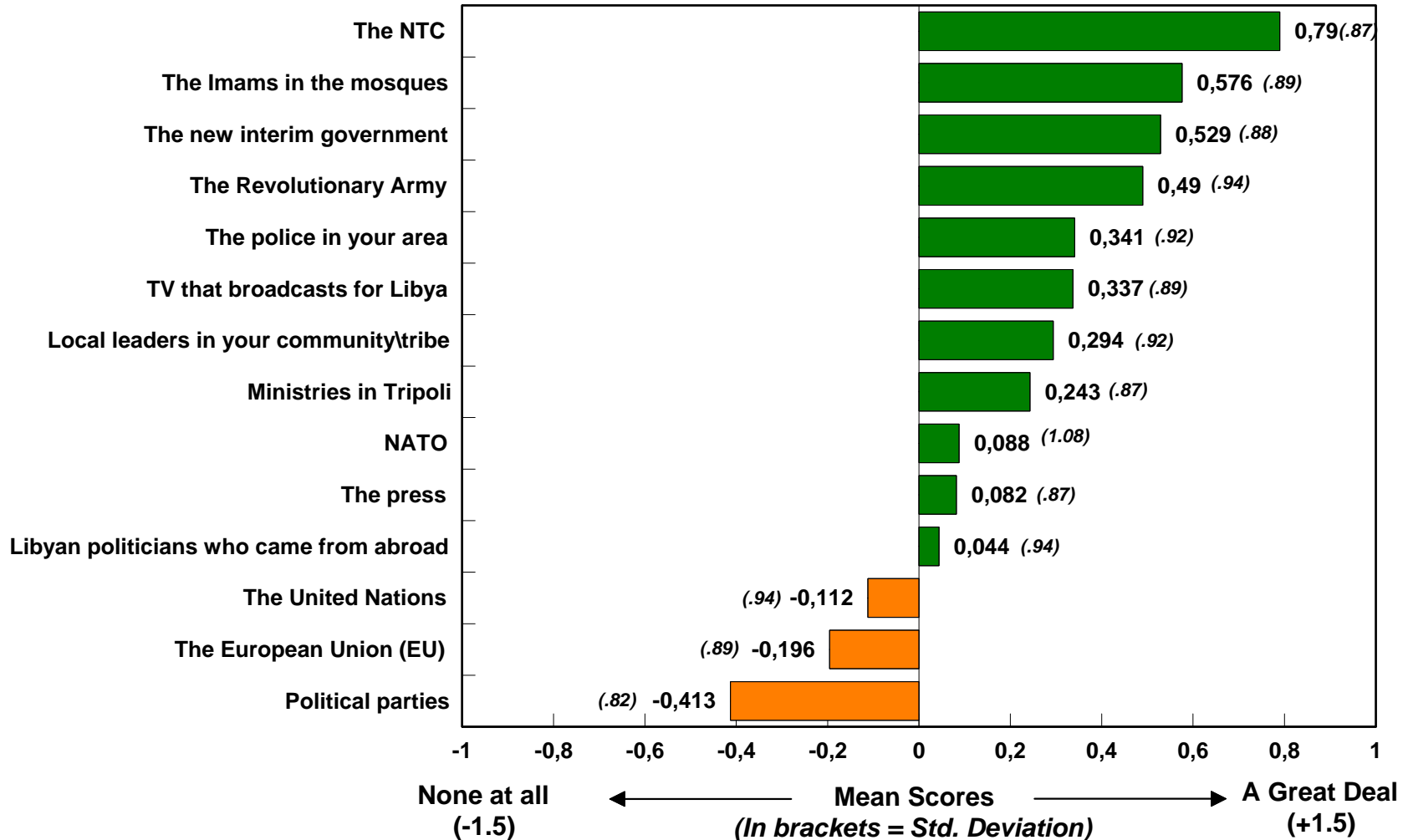

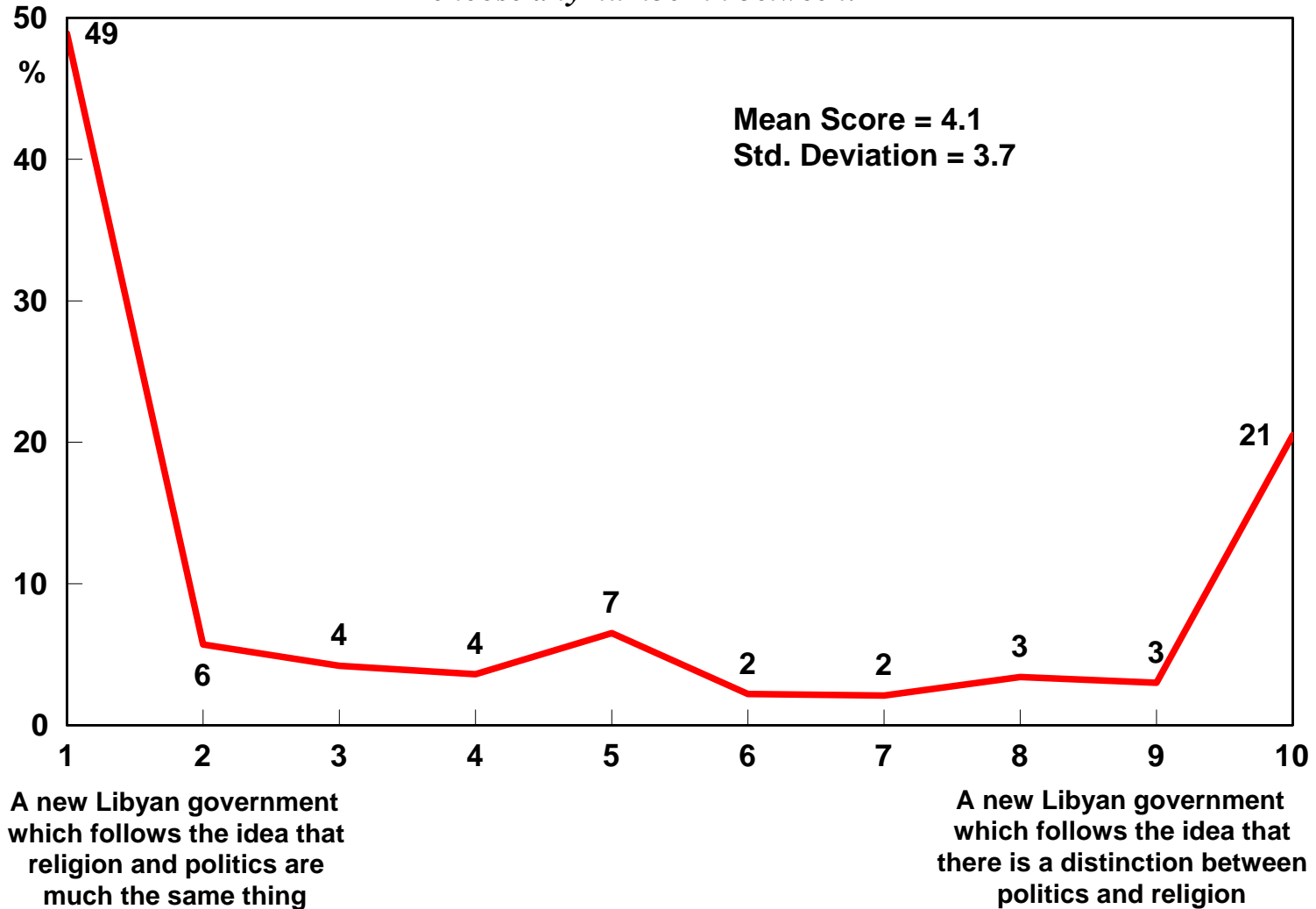

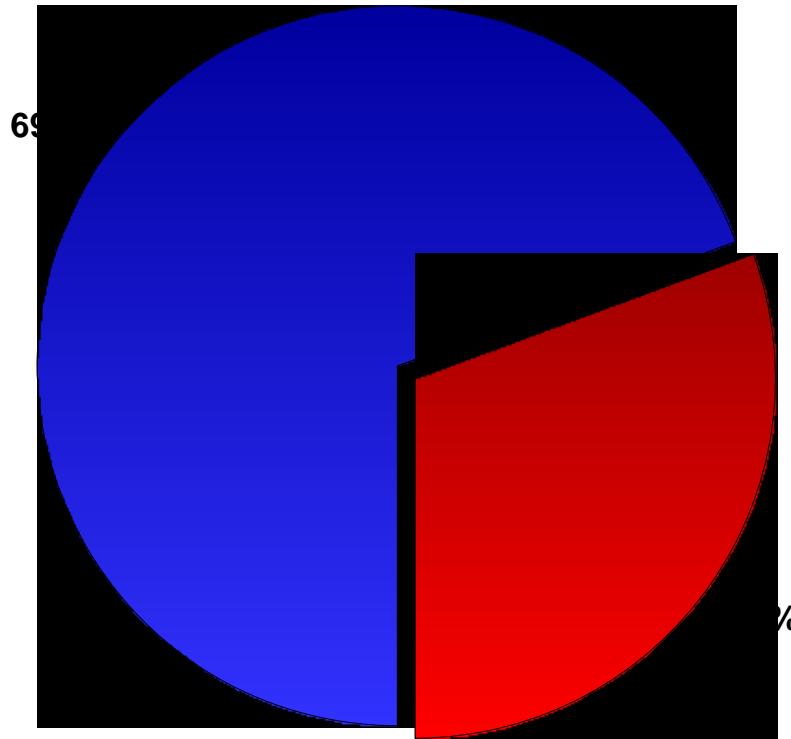
# Religion and Politics

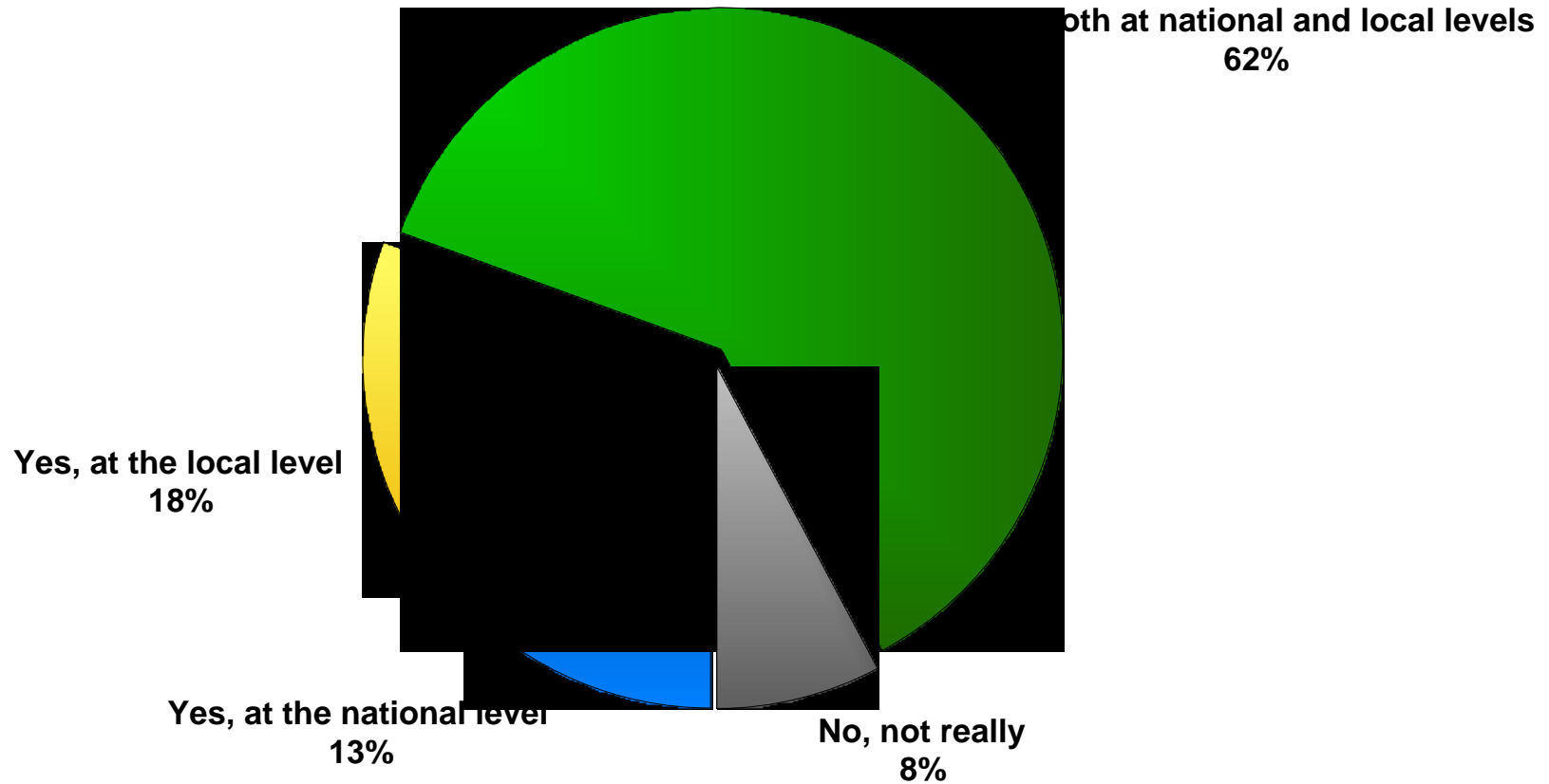

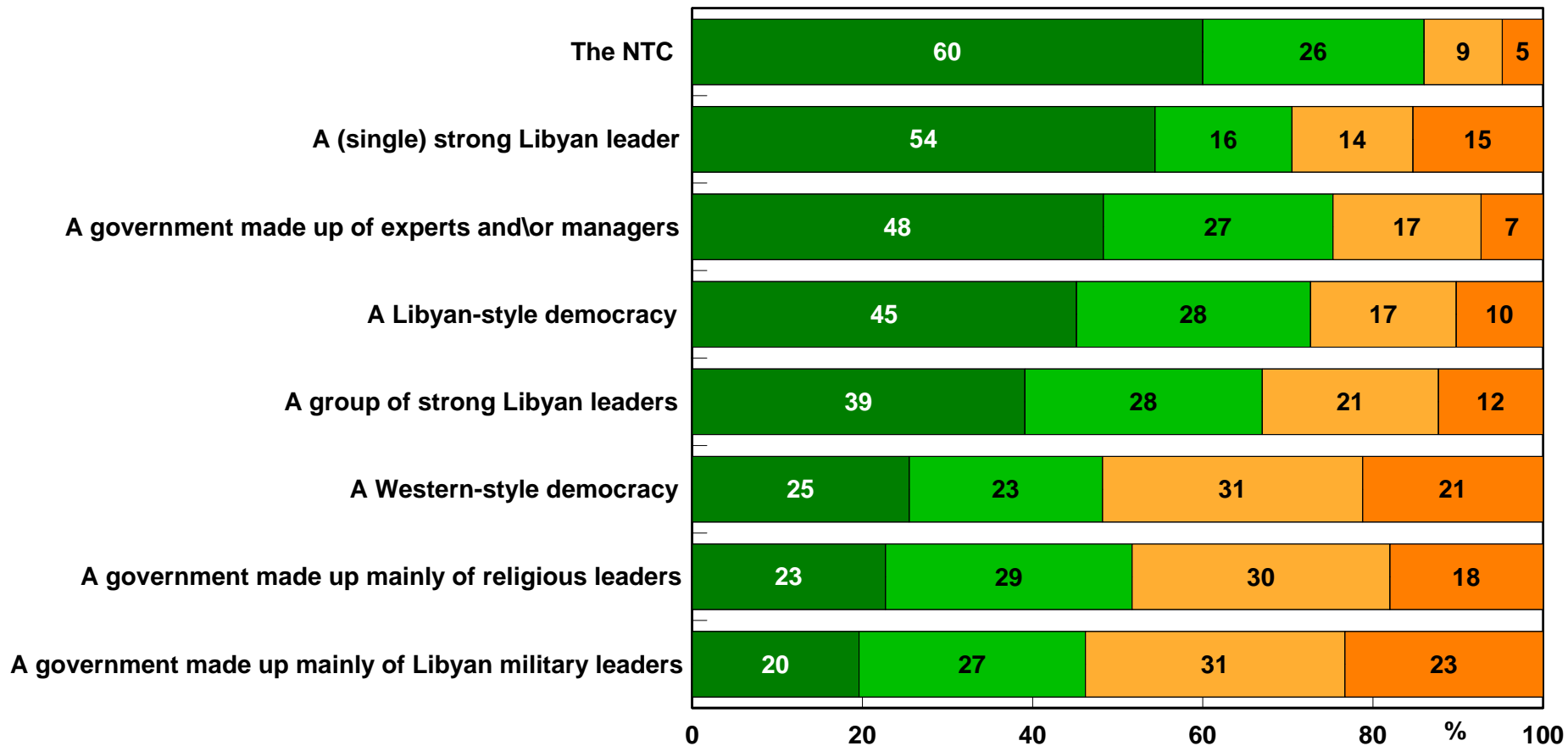

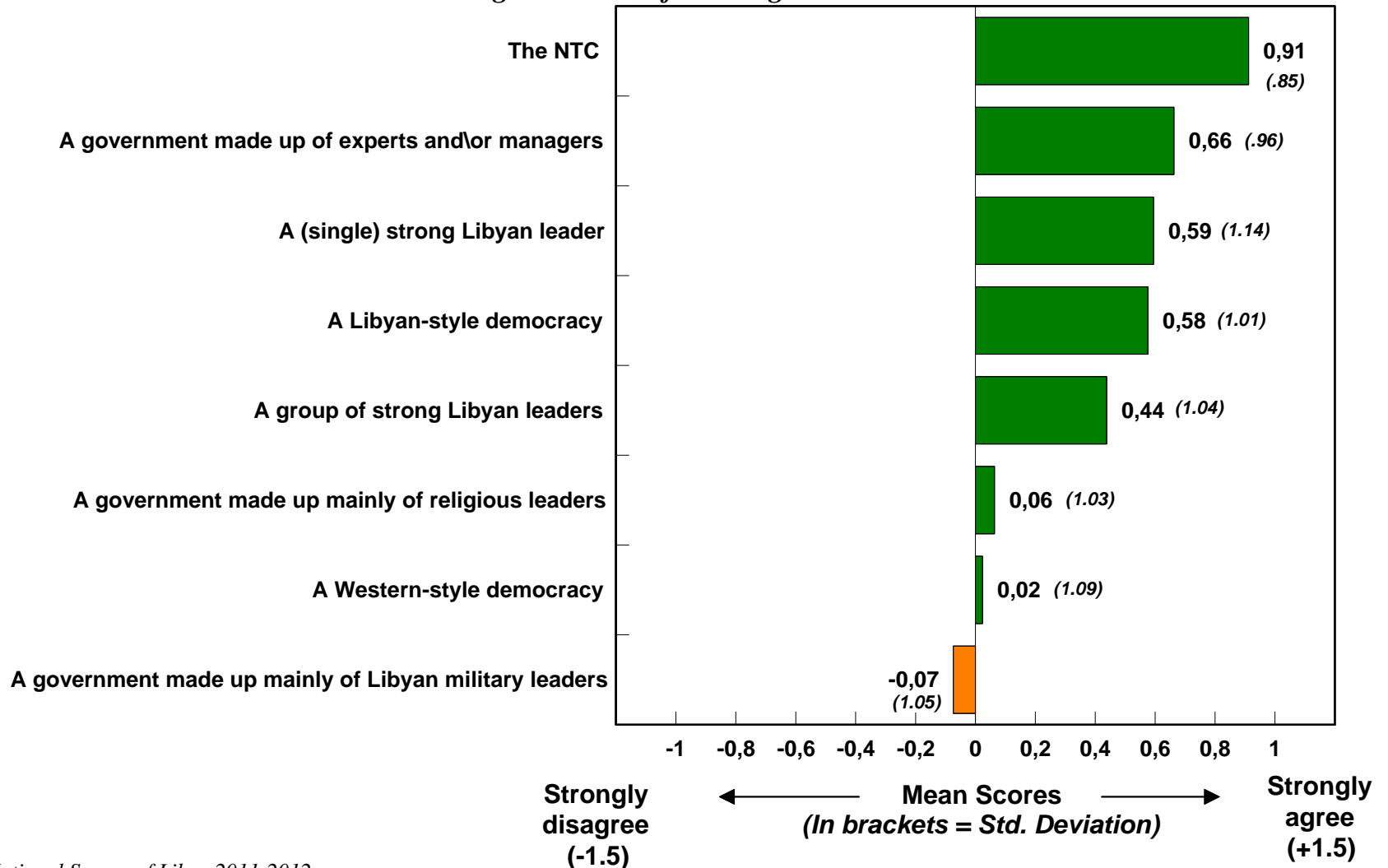

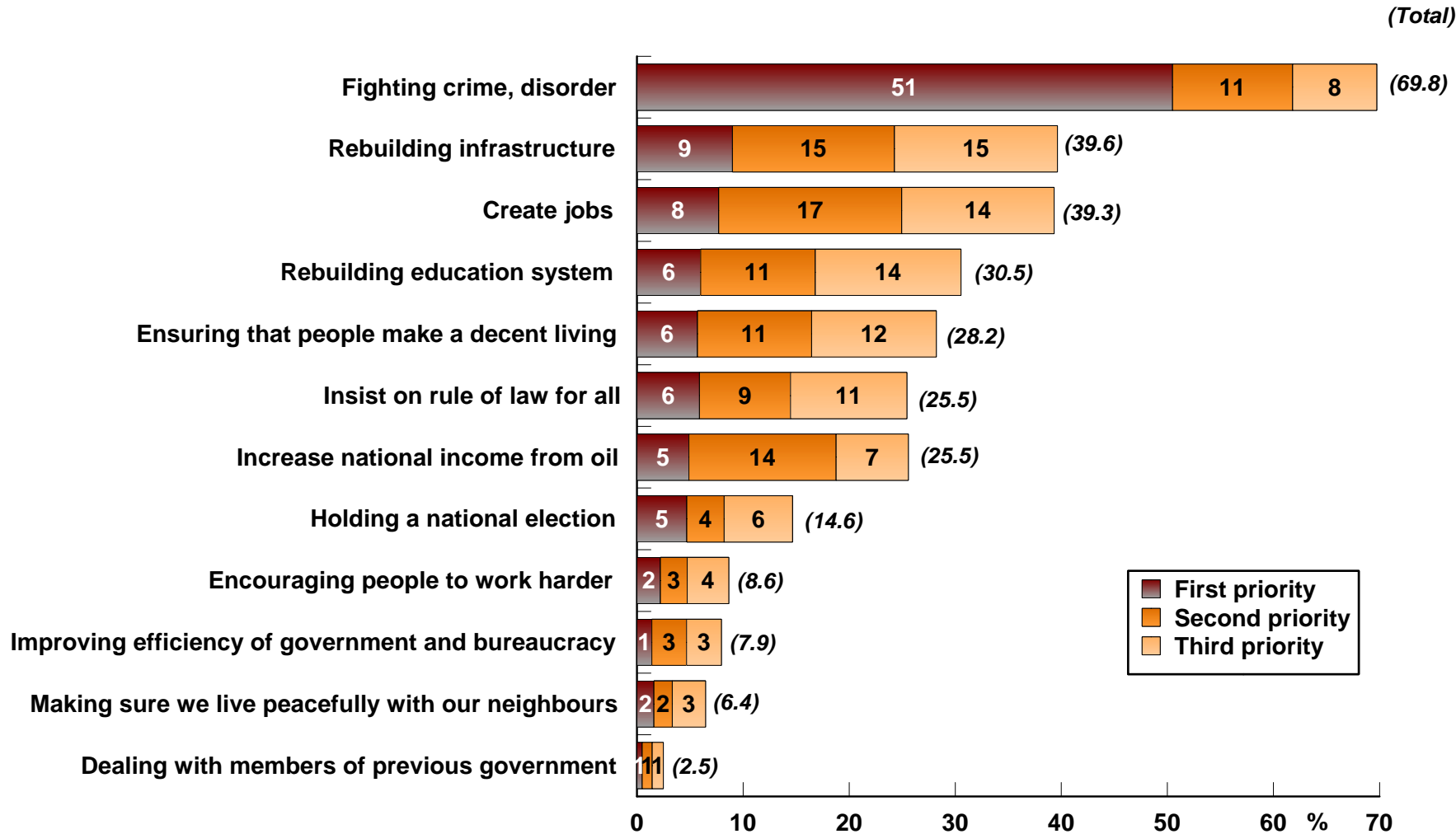

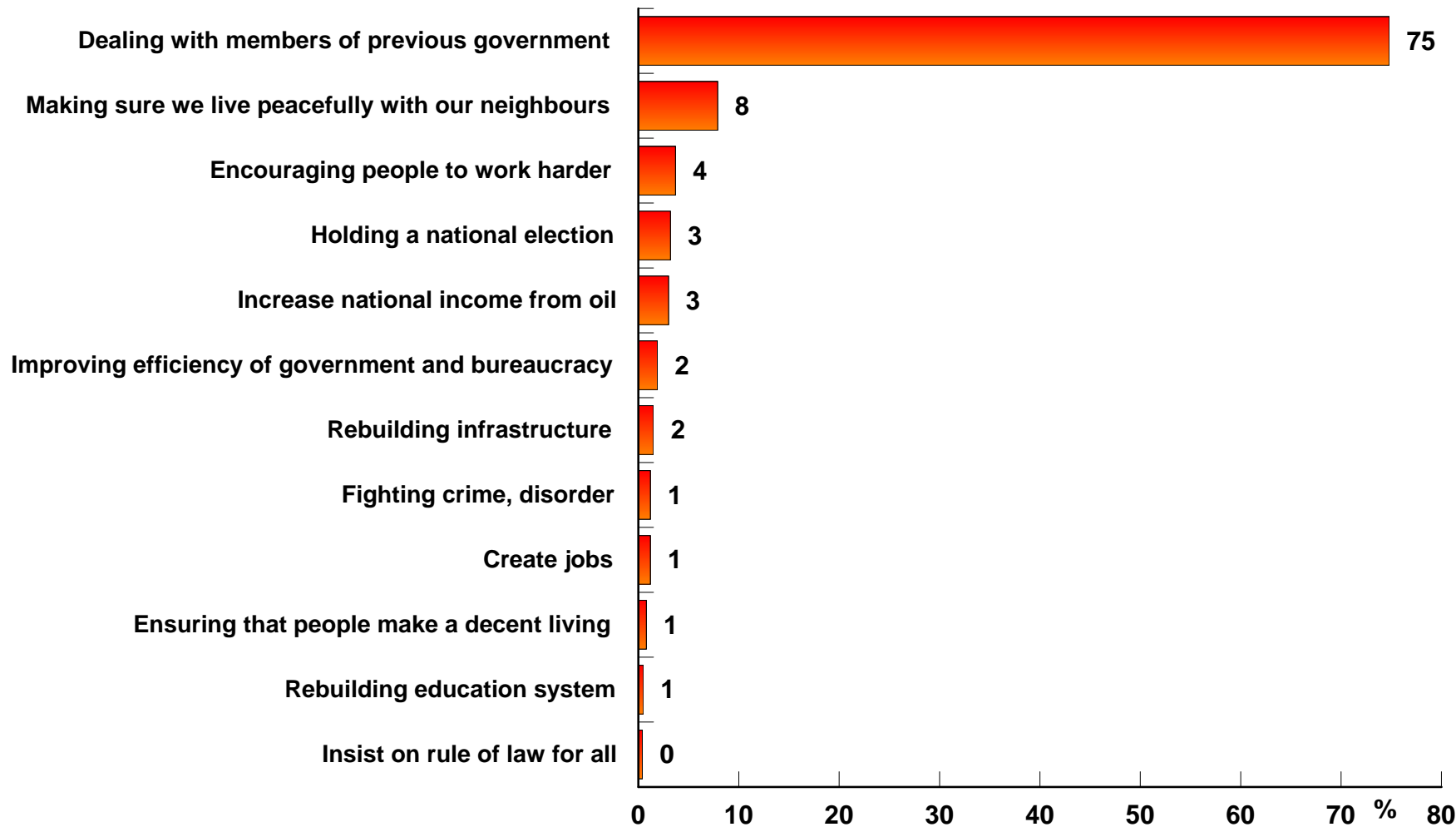

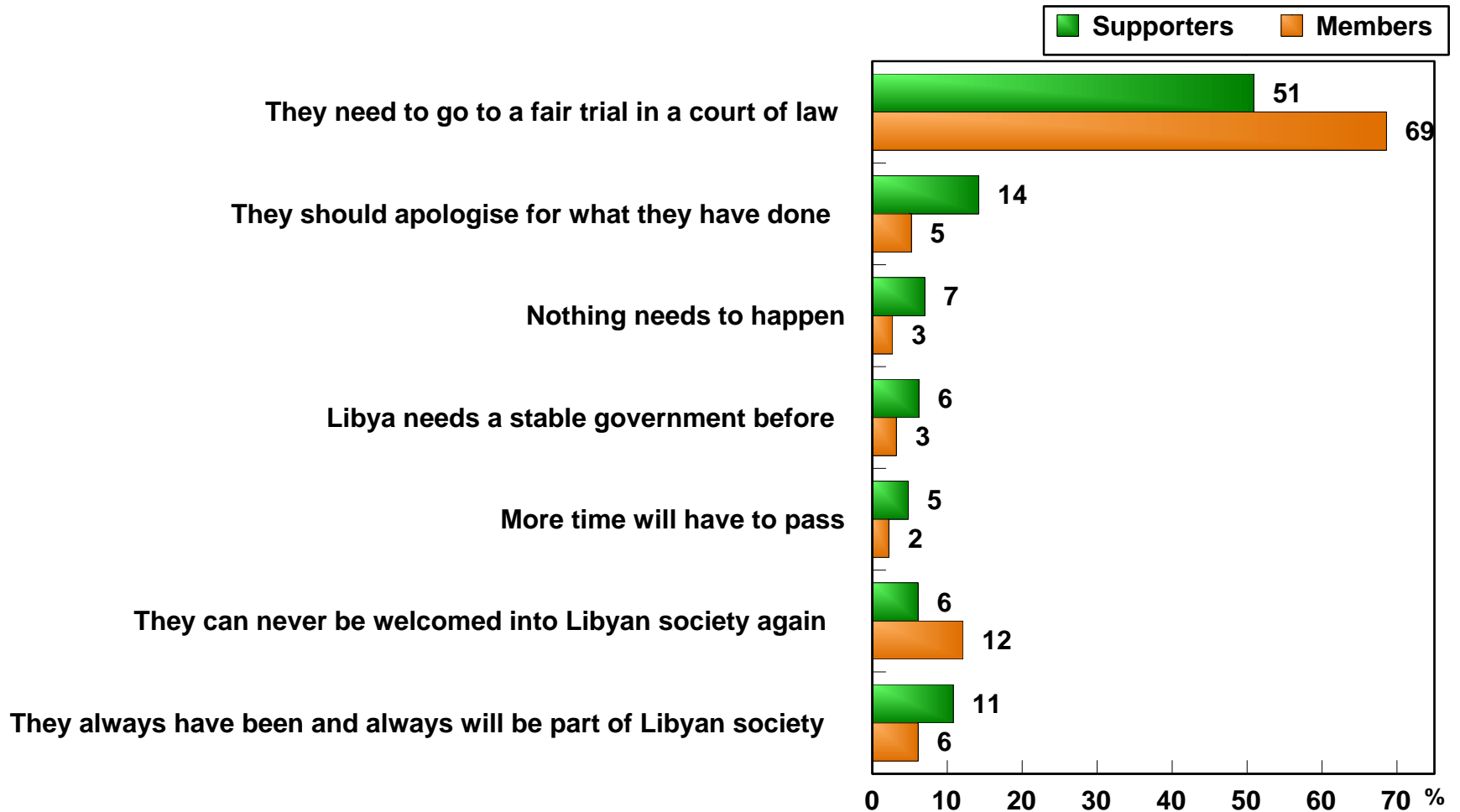

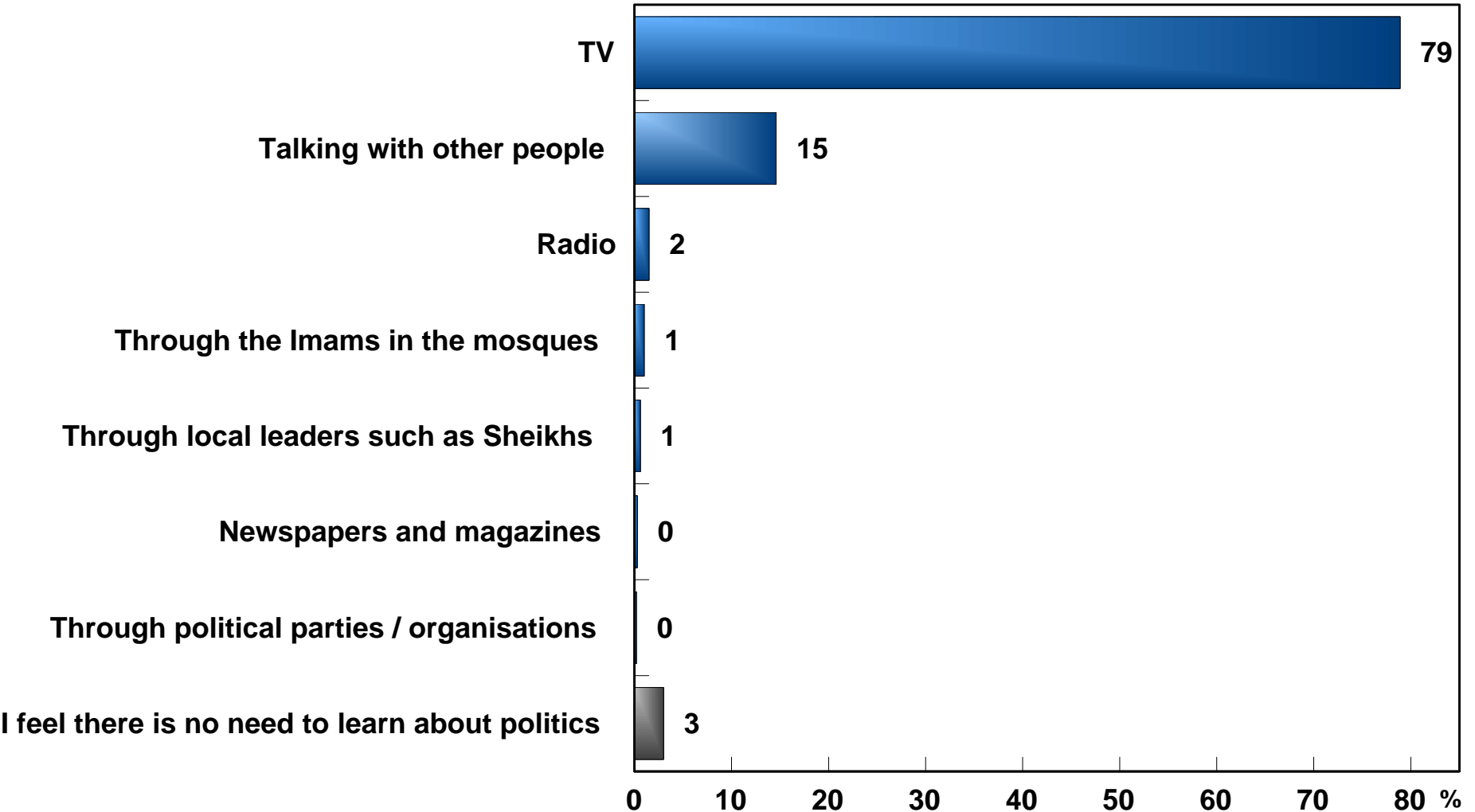

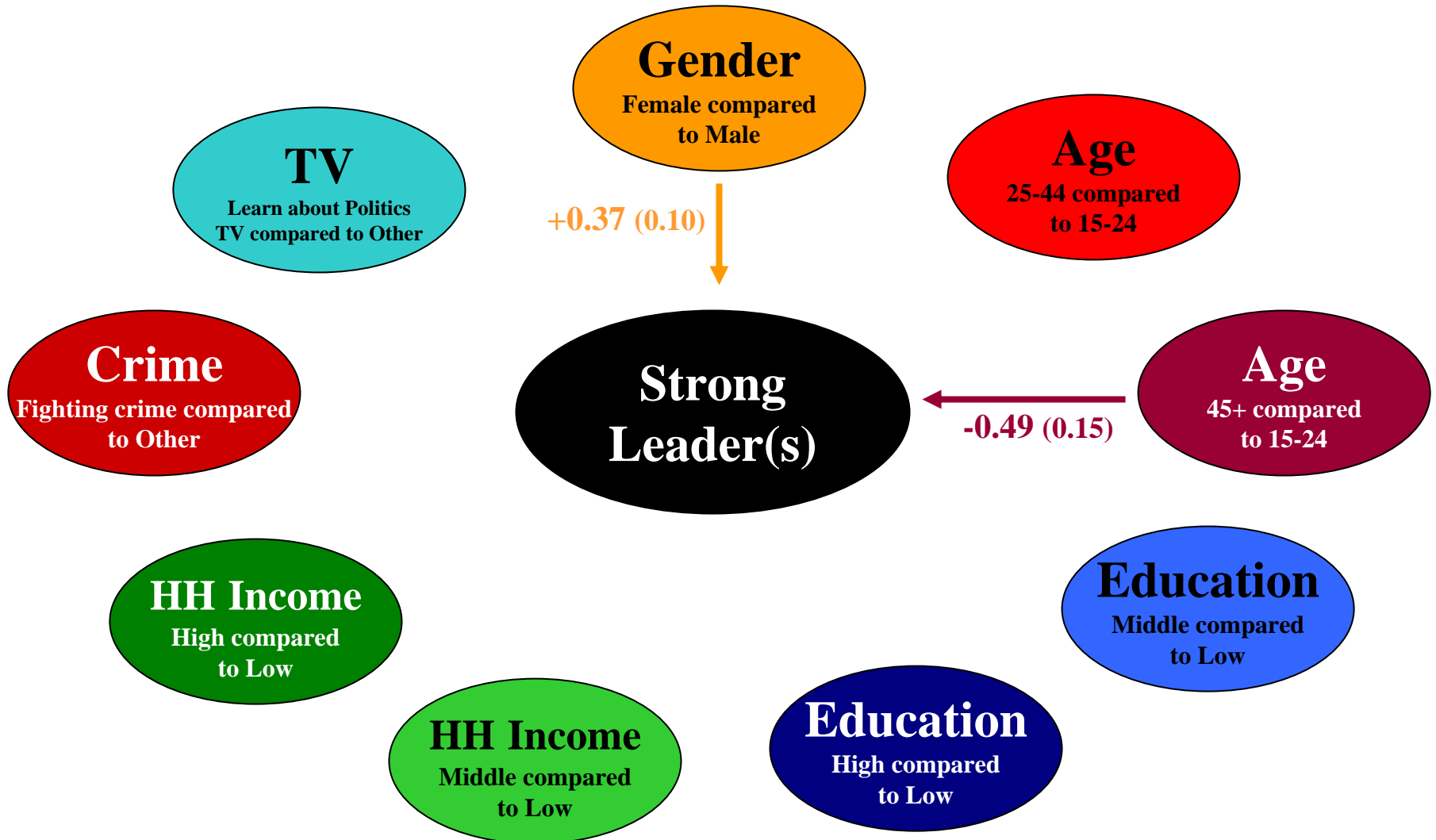

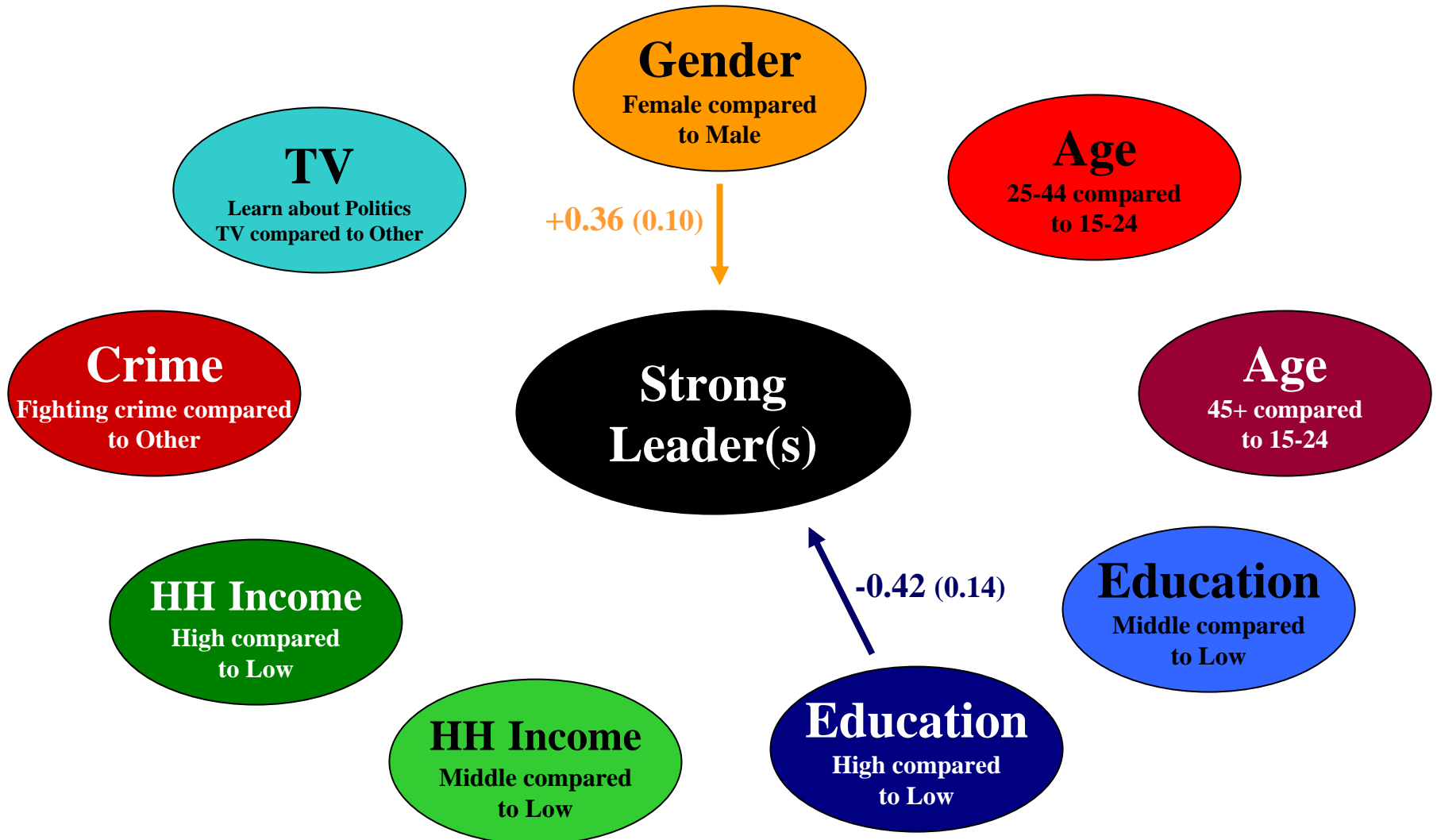

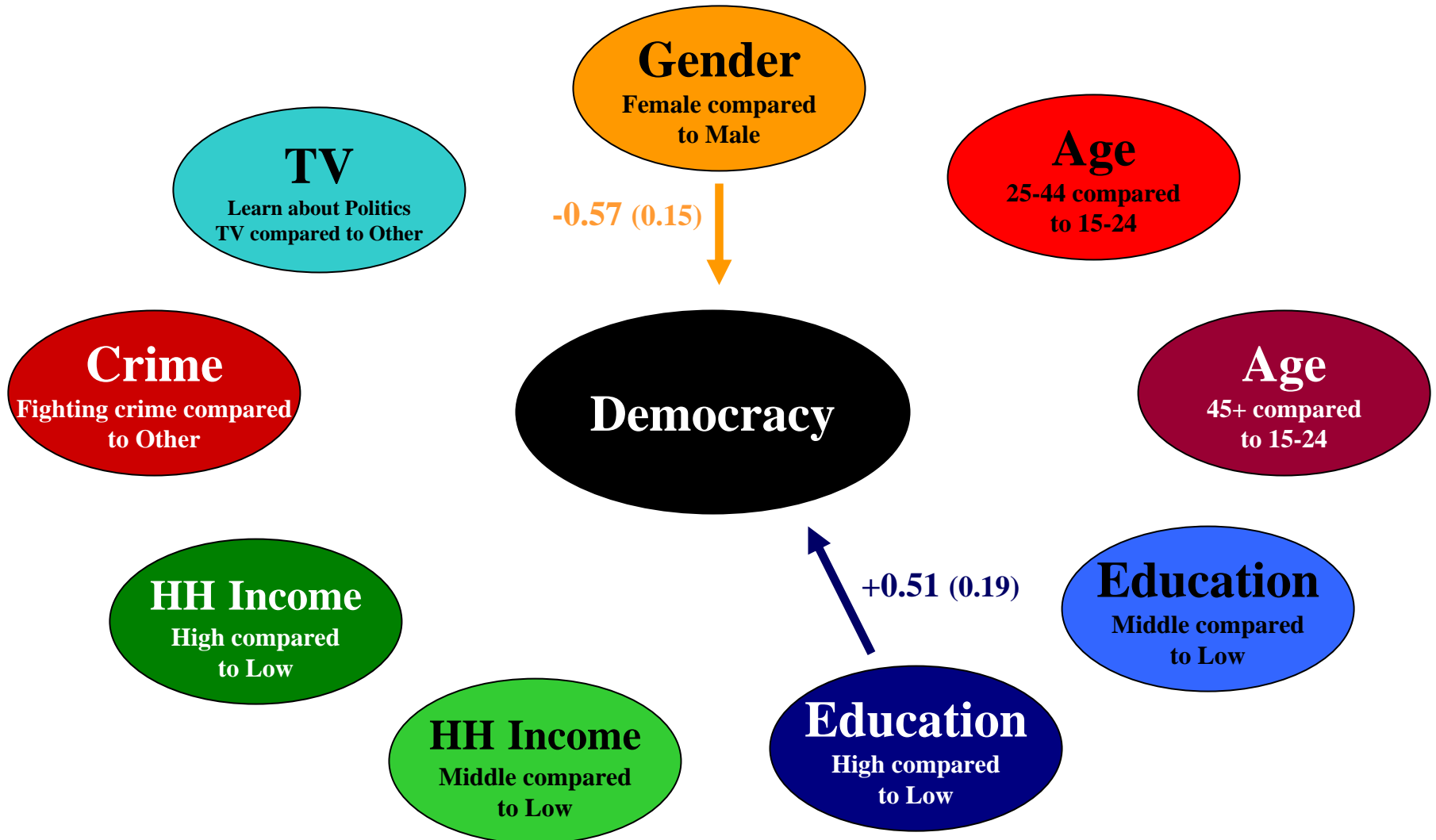

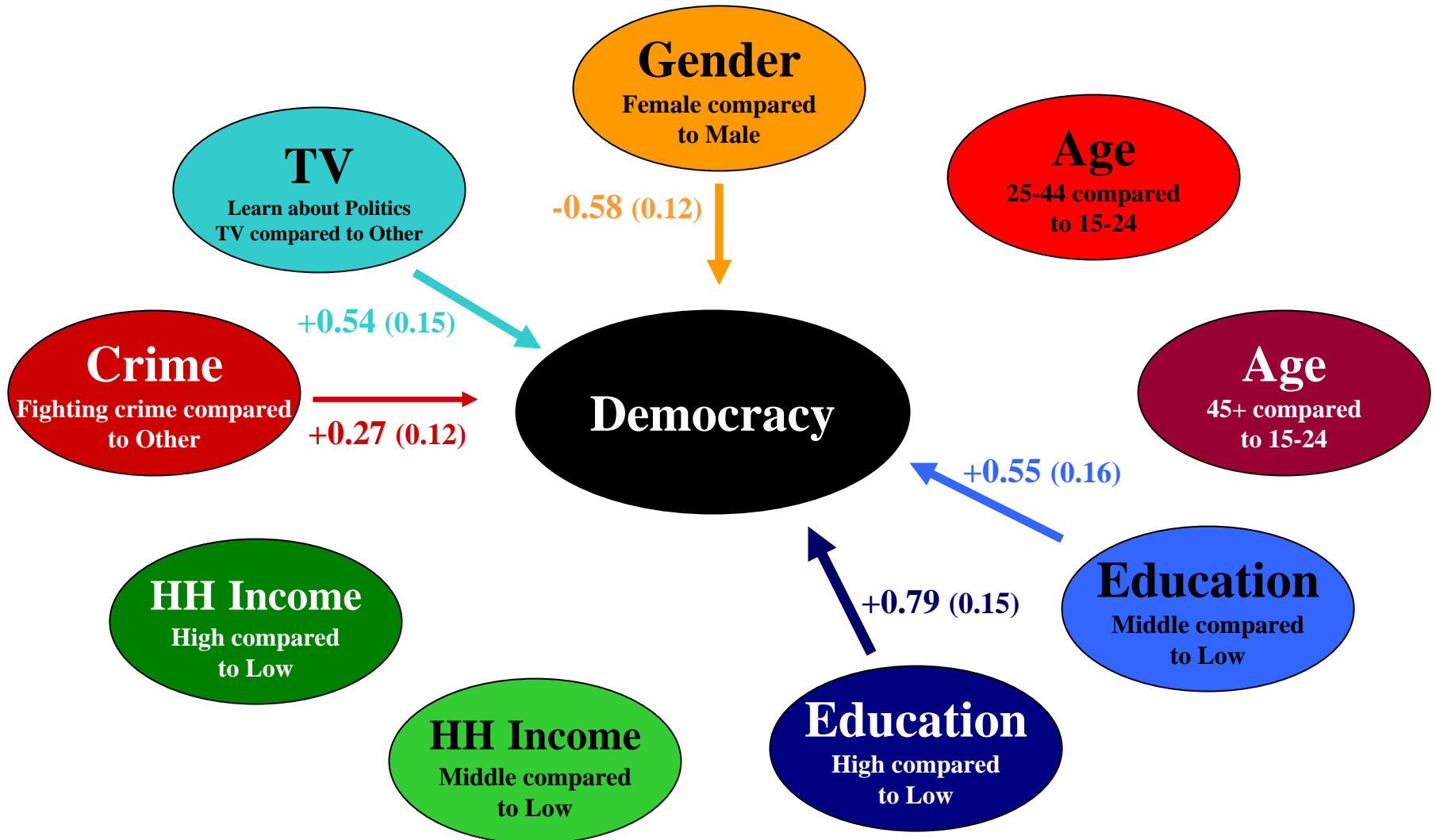

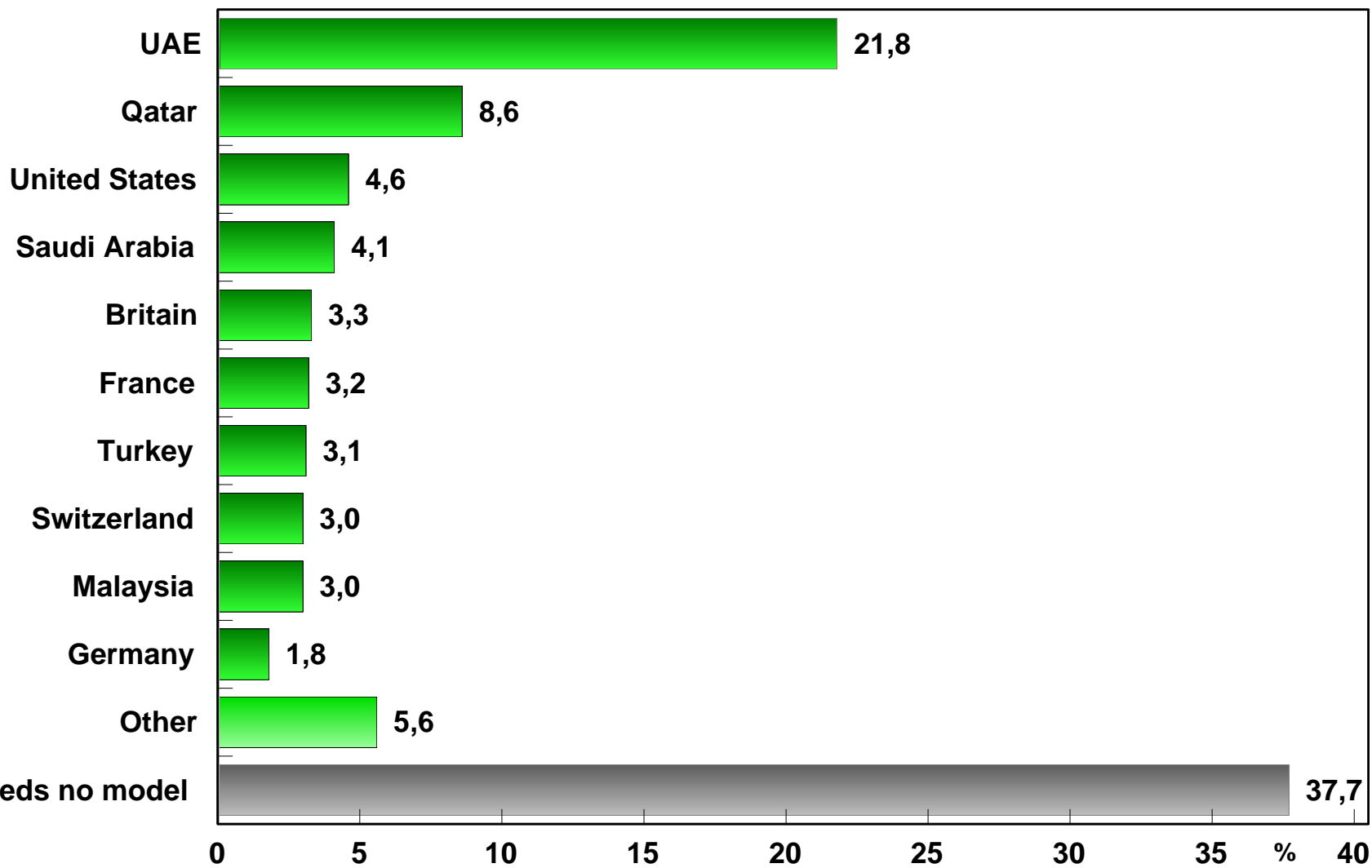

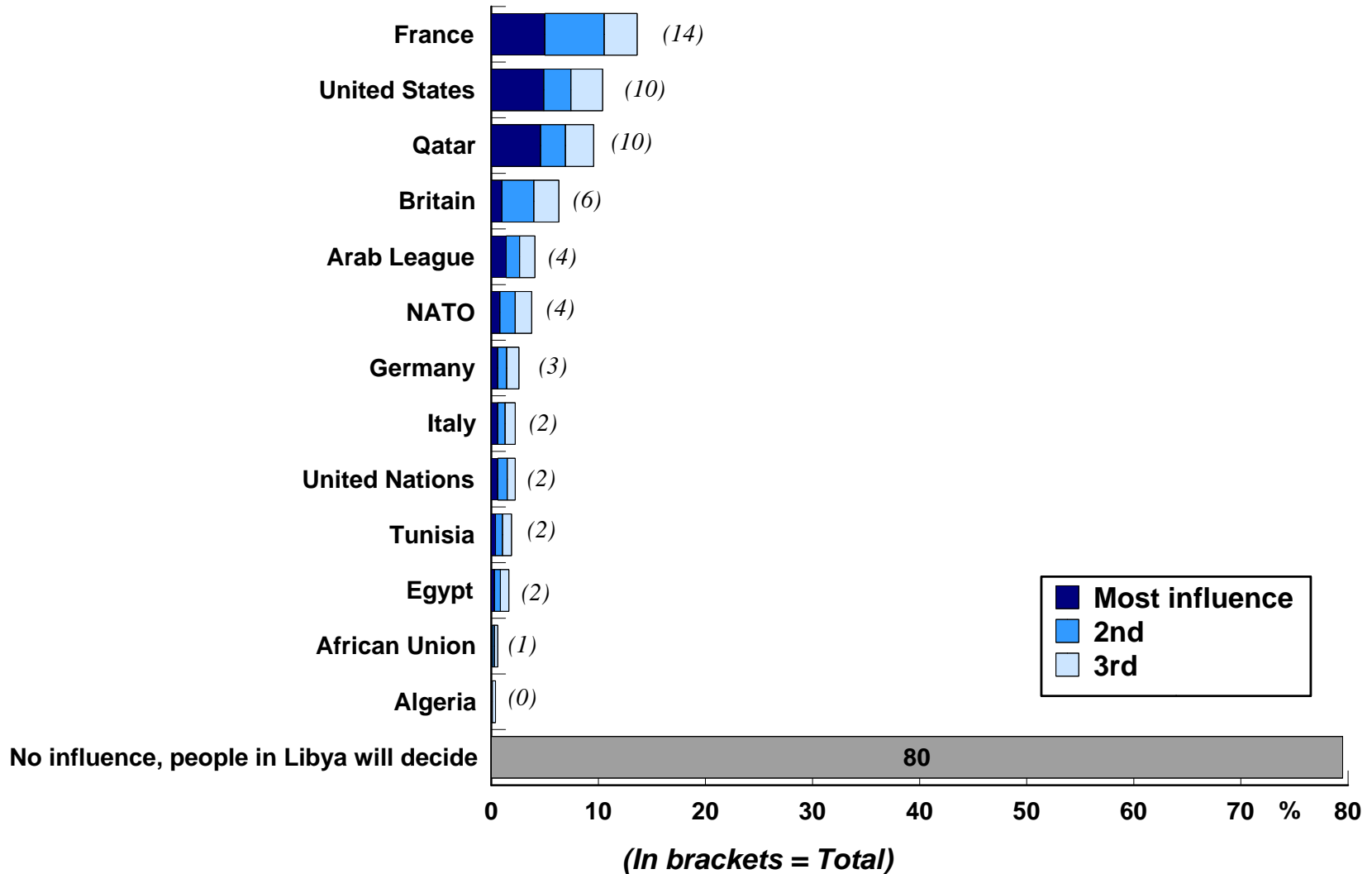

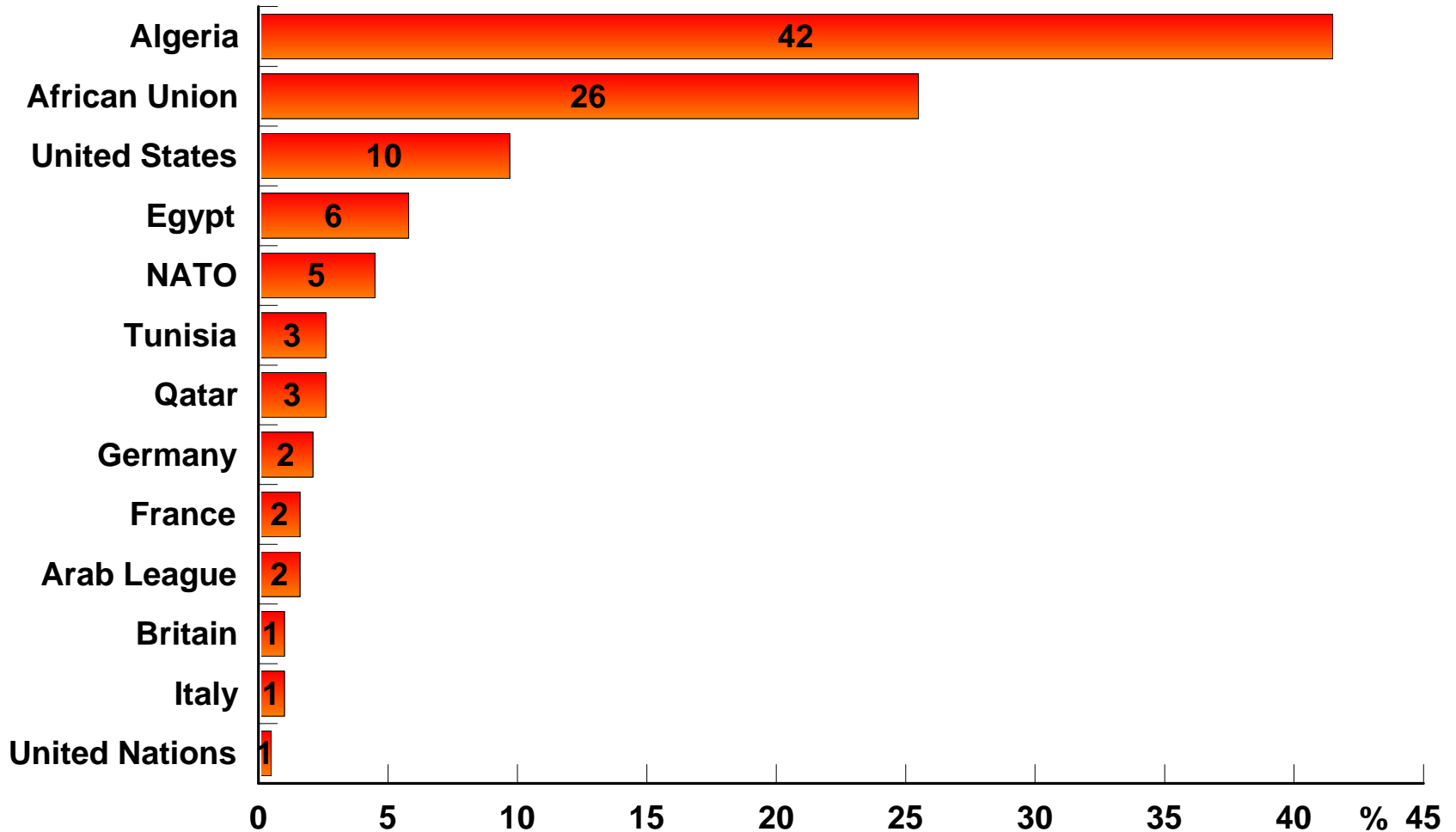

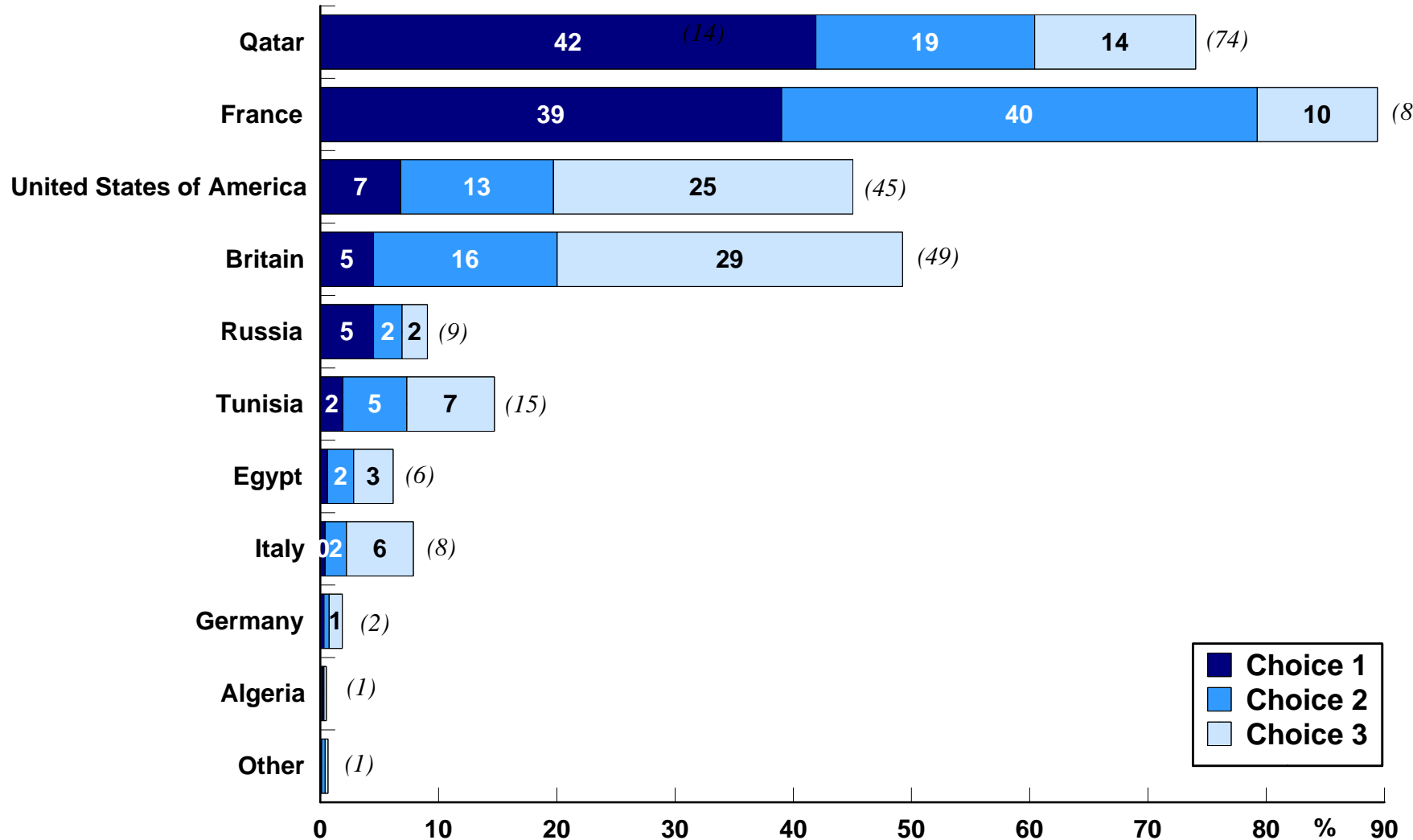

Q28A - Please rank the following countries according to their contribution in helping to oust the old regime from power. (Total)



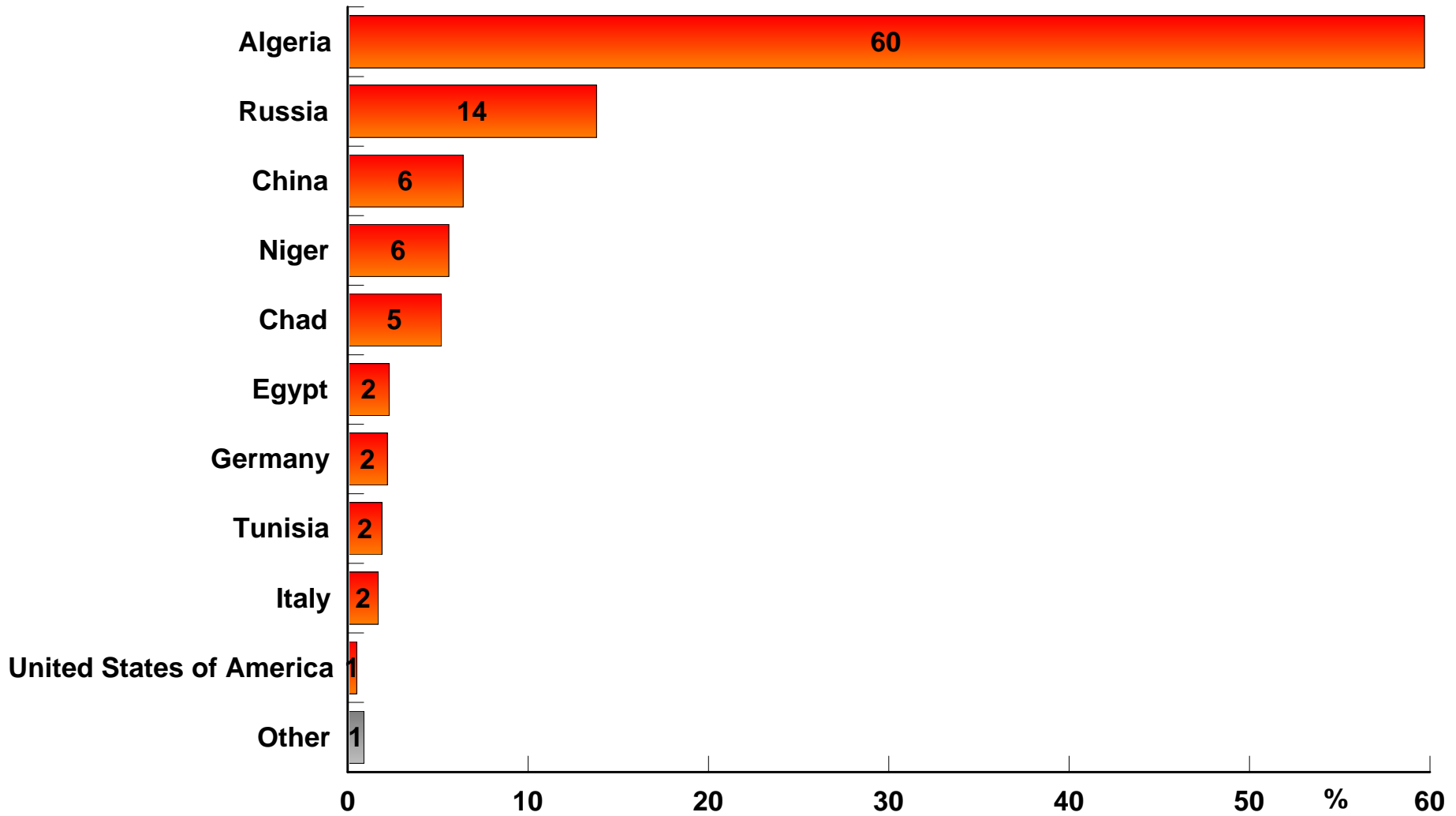

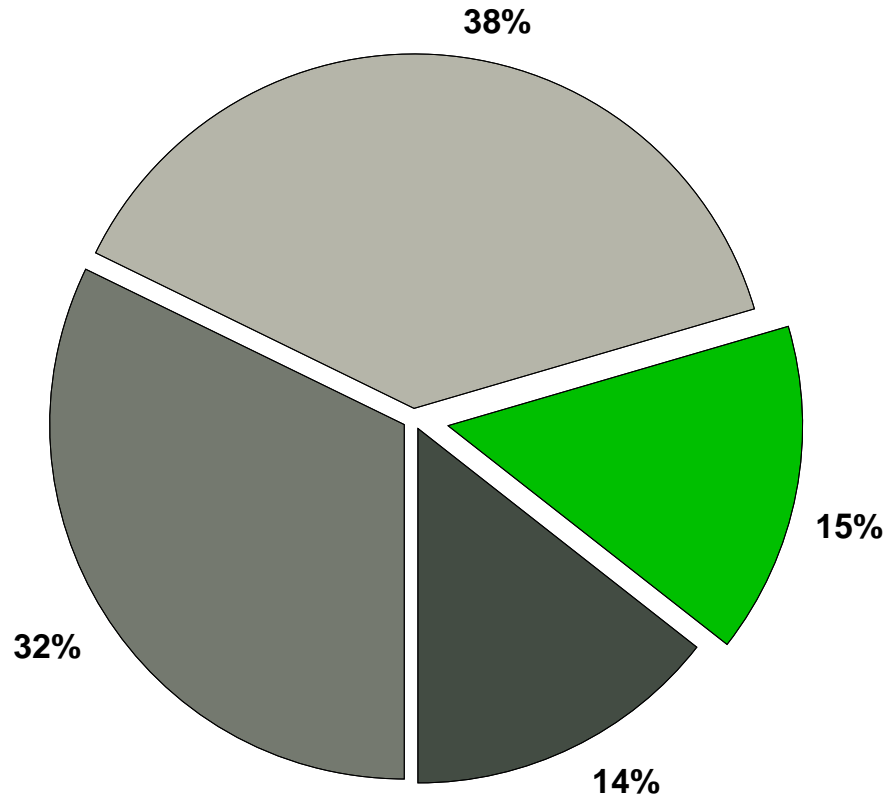
